MENOMINEE, WINNEBAGO, AND NEW YORK INDIANS

Articles of a Treaty, made and concluded at Green Bay, in the Territory of Michigan, between Tahyutaneke, alias John Anthony, Tahnonsongotha, alias John Skenardo, Onongwato, alias Cornelius Bear, Iganawaty, alias Thomas Christian, of the Oneida nation; Yawentanawen, alias Abraham Lafont, of the Onondaga nation; Dagaoyoseh, alias Jacob Jameson, Wausaugwis, alias George Jameson, of the Seneca nation; Deputies authorized and empowered to represent an association of the Six Nations or Tribes of Indians of the State of New York; Eleazer Williams, alias Onawenhiaki, a deputy, authorized and empowered to represent the St Regis Indians of the State of New York; Uhhawnowawumut, alias Solomon W. Hendrick, Wausaunah, alias Jacob Kunkapot, Wenowwamaug, alias Abner Hendrick, Chick sokun, alias Jacob Chicks, Nankawate, alias Robert Kunkapot; deputies authorized and empowered to represent the Stockbridge Nation a tribe of Indians of the State of New York; Rufus Turkey, alias Katakosakont, a deputy authorized and empowered to represent the Munsee nation a tribe of Indians; and Chiefs and head men of the Menominee and Winnebago Nations of Indians, residing in the vicinity of Green Bay aforesaid, this Eighteenth day of August, in the year One thousand Eight hundred and Twentyone.

Article first: The Menominee and Winnebago nations of Indians, in consideration of the stipulations herein made on the part of the Six Nations, and the St Regis, Stockbridge and Munsee nations of Indians, do hereby Cede, Release and Quit Claim, to the people of the said Six Nations, and the said St Regis, Stockbridge and Munsee nations, forever, all the right, title, interest and claim, of them, the Menominee and Winnebago nations of Indians, to the Lands, described by and comprehended within the following boundaries, viz: Beginning at the foot of the rapids, usually called the Grand Kaccalin, on the Fox river; thence running up the said river to the rapids at the Winnebago Lake; and from the river extending back in this width on each side, to the Northwest and to the South East, equidistant with the claims of the said Menominee and Winnebago nations of Indians.

Article Second: The Six Nations, and the St Regis, Stockbridge and Munsee nations of Indians, do promise and agree to and with the Menominee and Winnebago nations of Indians, that they the Menominee and Winnebago shall reserve to themselves, the right to use and occupy a necessary proportion of the Lands, herein Ceded, for the purposes, of hunting, and also the right of fishing; provided nevertheless, that they the Menominee and Winnebagoes in such use and occupation, shall commit no waste or depredation on such Lands, as may be under actual improvement by either of the said Six Nations, or the St Regis, Stockbridge or Munsee nations.

Article third: In consideration of the cession aforesaid, the Six Nations, and the St Regis, Stockbridge and Munsee nations aforesaid, do agree to pay to the Menominee and Winnebago nations aforesaid, within one year from the date hereof, the sum of Fifteen hundred dollars in goods; and

and they have also given to the said Winnebago and Menominee nations, this day, Five hundred Dollars; the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Menominee and Winnebago Nations.

In Testimony whereof, the said Deputies and the said Chiefs and head Men, have hereunto set their hands and seals, at the place & on the day and year aforesaid.
