The American Society for Gastrointestinal Endoscopy and C.R. BARD, Inc. are pleased to announce the fifth annual ASGE / C.R. BARD Outstanding Manuscript Prize Award competition. The prize will consist of a \$10,000 cash award to the Fellow or Resident in training in a gastroenterology or a surgical gastrointestinal endoscopic program whose manuscript is accepted in 2003 for publication in *GASTROINTESTINAL ENDOSCOPY*.

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a Fellow in an accredited gastroenterology or GI surgical training program at time of submission
- Must be an ASGE Trainee Member
- Must be the primary author of an original endoscopically oriented manuscript which presents clinical or experimental research

AWARD

• \$10,000 cash award will go to the Fellow who is the primary author of the winning manuscript

APPLICATION

- Manuscripts must be prepared according to "Instructions to Authors" as published in *GASTROINTESTINAL ENDOSCOPY*
- A transmittal letter from the Training Program Director confirming that the work has been conducted by the Fellow must be submitted with the manuscript
- A transmittal letter from the Fellow to the Editor of GASTROINTESTINAL ENDOSCOPY requesting that the manuscript be considered for the award must be submitted with the manuscript
