reed had 136 VOTED, That authority be granted the Business Manager to request the Emergency Board for \$10,000 for the purchase of the 160 acre farm in La Crosse County, \$9,000 purchase price and \$1,000 for improvement of the property, to be used for the establishing of a soil erosion investigation farm; the farm to be used jointly by the Wisconsin Experiment Station and the U.S. Department of Agriculture with the understanding that the U.S. Department of Agriculture is to pay all equipment and operating costs. The land is described as follows:

> The W  $\frac{1}{2}$  NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 35, and the E  $\frac{1}{2}$  NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 34, T. 16 R. 7 W, La Crosse County, Wisconsin.

Upon recommendation of Beulah Dahle, Acting Director of Dormitories and Commons, the following recommendations were adopted:
