

April 1 to April 21, 1950

In 1940 a group of 30 people submitting 68 pictures made up the first Rural Art Show. The number of entries has multiplied so greatly since then that regional rural art shows have been presented throughout the state to pick the outstanding works. The exhibits reflect the everyday scenes and objects of the people's own environments. Rural people have been influenced very little by formal art training.

Each year the University College of Agriculture purchases works of art chosen for originality of concept and which add variety to their permanent collection. These paintings and drawings, which are not necessarily the outstanding works of the exhibition, will be sent throughout the state to build further interest in rural art.

The Rural Art Show is sponsored by the Blue Shield Club and the Rural Sociology Department of the College of Agriculture in cooperation with the Wisconsin Union Gallery Committee.

TO BE ELIGIBLE, exhibitors in the Rural Art Show must be living on farms, in rural communities or have farm backgrounds. All entries must be original works of art which have never been exhibited before in a State Show.
