REQUESTS CAN BE MADE IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING WAYS:

- 1) ahsathu·táte? kΛ (literally - “will you consent to....”)
- 2) awa·tú· kΛ (literally – “is it possible for....”)
- 3) command form
- 4) háo? plus the command form (literally an invitation)

háo? satekhu·ní·
