REQUESTS CAN BE MADE IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING WAYS:

- 1) Λhsathu·táte? kΛ (literally - “will you consent to....”)
- 2) Λwa·tú· kΛ (literally – “is it possible for.....”)
- 3) command form
- 4) háoʔ plus the command form (literally an invitation)
