HISTORY:

She was in the passenger and freight service and had gangways. She later belonged to the Leopold & Austrian Lake Michigan & Lake Superior Line and traded steadily between Chicago, Milwaukee and as far west as Duluth. In 1905 she was used as a gambling ship outside of Chicago. In 1907 she belonged to the Graham & Morton Line. She was abandoned in 1915 and converted into a dry dock at St. Joseph.
