

Two hundred artists submitted three hundred and thirty-one works of art in oil and tempera, watercolor, pastel, sculpture, and graphics, with a limit of two entries per person.

One hundred and eleven works were selected by the jury for exhibition in the Salon. Represented in this selection are the works of ninety-four Wisconsin artists.

The contributors who were eligible have had three years of residence in Wisconsin including the past year, or were ten year residents in Wisconsin if now living outside the state, or are students now attending Wisconsin art schools.
