TEN YEARS of exhibition of rural art at the University of Wisconsin by the College of Agriculture has encouraged an extraordinary development in art in Wisconsin rural areas.

This year the pictures in the Madison exhibit were selected from twelve regional rural art shows that were presented throughout the state this past season. These regional rural art shows were held in Dodgeville, Oregon, Sheboygan Falls, Sparta, Ashland, Merrill, Superior, Prairie du Chien, Wisconsin Rapids, Racine, Green Bay and Eau Claire. The selection of from seven to nine pictures in each regional was made by members of the Department of Art Education Faculty, University of Wisconsin, and Aaron Bohrod, Artist in Residence. The artists so selected were requested to send their works to Madison for this exhibition.

The University College of Agriculture purchases from the Rural Art Show a number of works of art to add to its permanent collection. The purchases are chosen each year for originality of concept and because they add variety to the collection. The committee wants to remind you that the purchased pieces are not necessarily the outstanding works in the exhibition.

The Rural Art Show is sponsored by the Blue Shield Club and the Rural Sociology Department of the College of Agriculture in cooperation with the Wisconsin Union Gallery Committee.
