

Translation:

Year six of Antonius Caesar the lord, the seventeenth Mecheir. With Callinicus, former village secretary, in attendance. And Callinicus having approached the tribunal, after other matters Eudaemon said to Callinicus: "What did you have in mind when you put forward an indigent man for liturgy? Being the cause of his flight, you (thereby) were the cause that his possessions were sold. You are subject to penalties. In the treasury office you will pay the fines, but, also, to him four times as much as that for which his property was sold."
