UNDERGRADUATE PRE-STRIKE BULLETIN #1

--The TAA goes on strike Monday, March 16. This week every student must decide to honor the picket lines or be a strike breaker.

--If every student honors the picket lines and supports a strike, the University will be forced to negotiate the TAA settlement.

Basically the settlement asks

1. For TAs-- an equitable grievance procedure appointment until proof of poor teaching, guaranteed half time appointments and a health plan.
2. For all students-- a portion of decision making power in educational planning, representation on the Workers Review Council, TA Review Council, and participation in mandatory TA evaluations.

SUPPORT THE TAA STRIKE --- JOIN THE PICKET LINES

--The picket lines will be maintained by picket captains trained by the Wisconsin School for Workers. TAs have already been assigned to picket captains. Undergraduates who wish to picket should report to the undergraduate strike center in the basement of the Catholic Center, where they will be assigned to a specific picket captain.

--At least 1000 TAs will picket. Sympathetic and peaceful support of the picket lines by undergraduates will help guarantee the success of the strike.

--DO NOT ENTER ANY UNIVERSITY BUILDING DURING THE STRIKE

If all students work together in supporting the strike, the TAA will win.

When the TAA wins, every student benefits.
