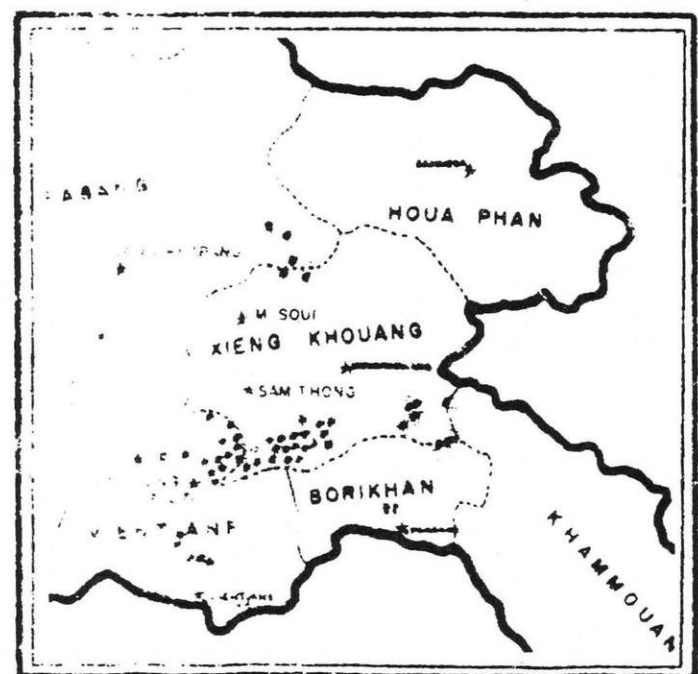

FROM 1963 TO 1968



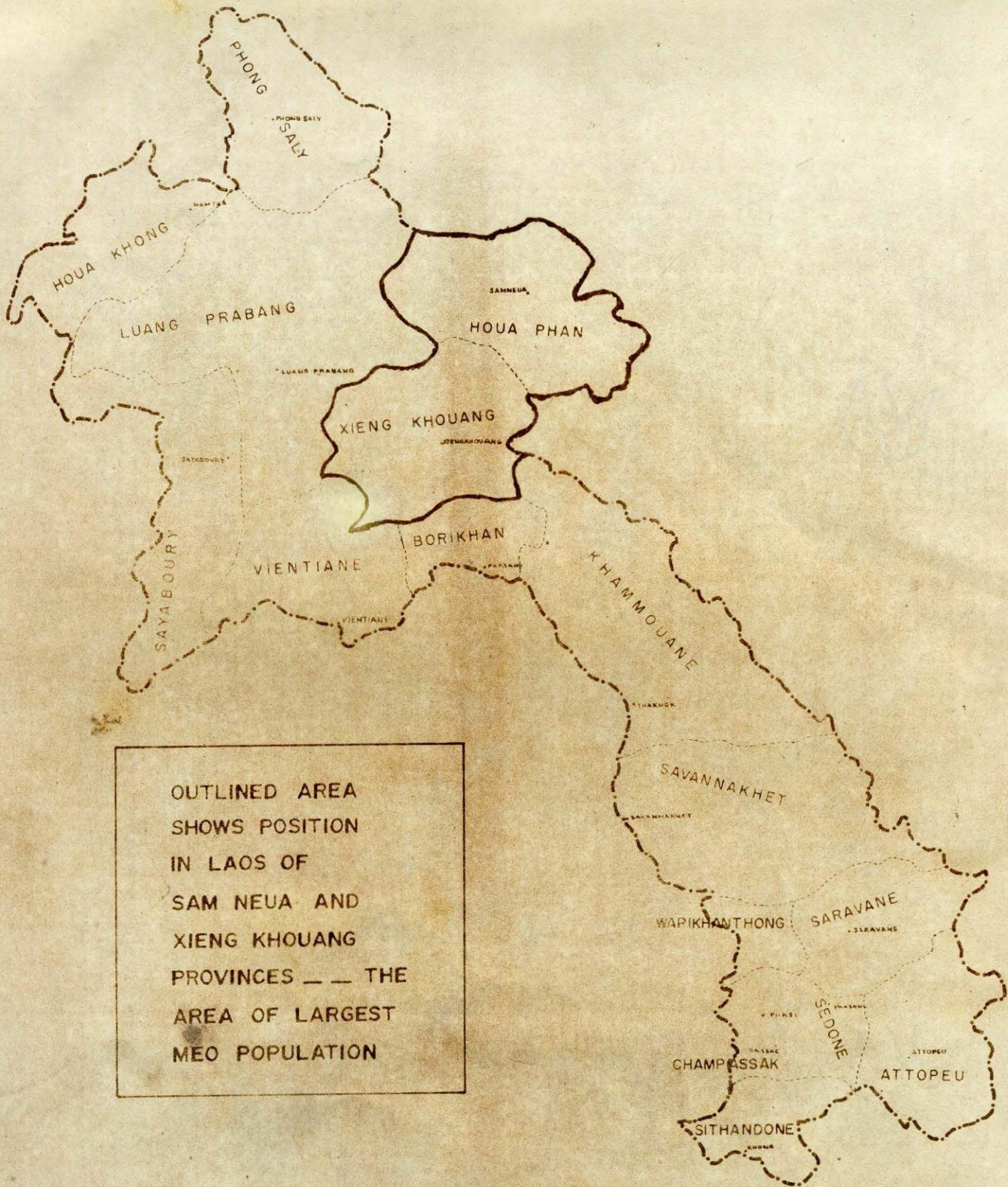

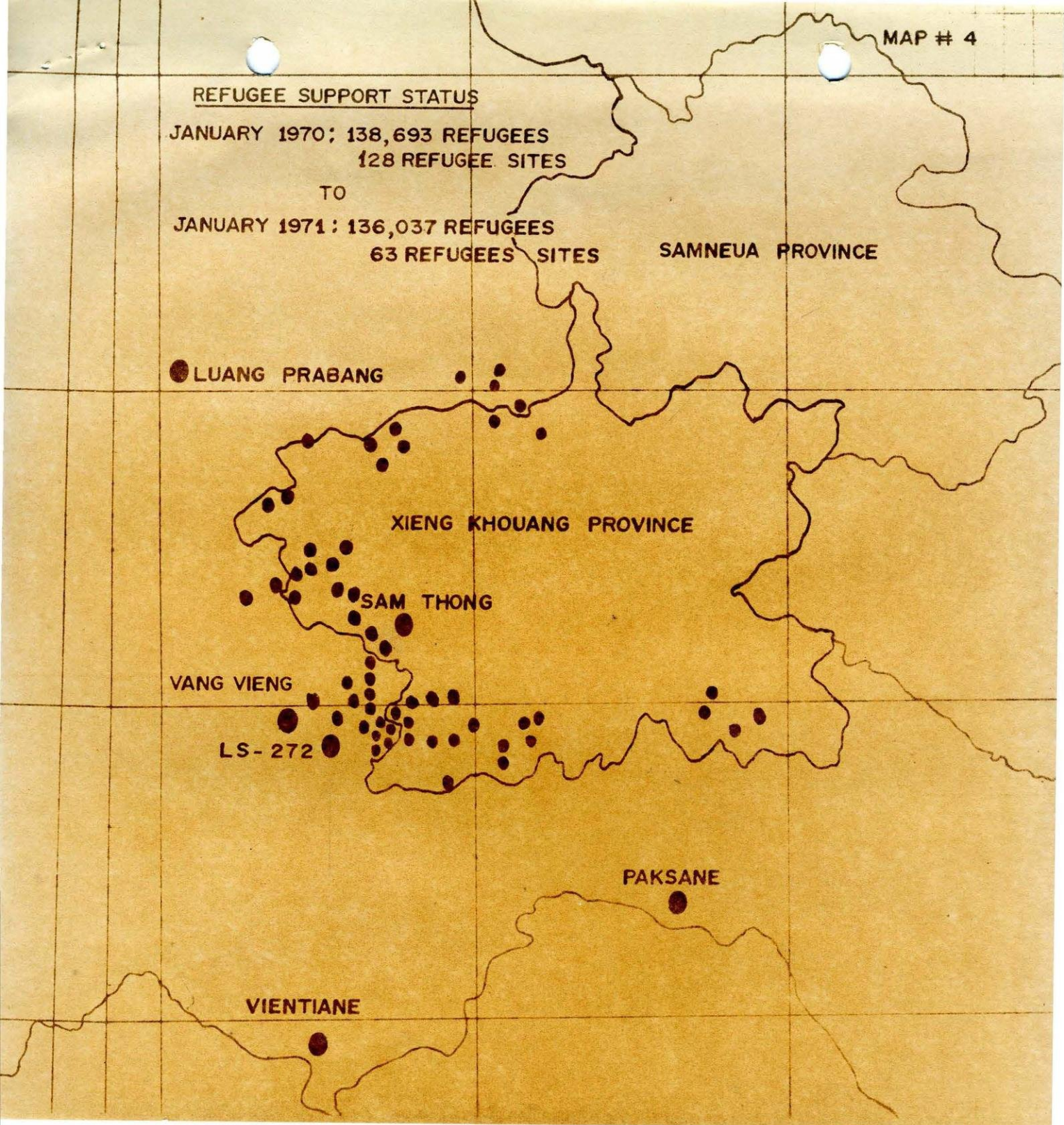

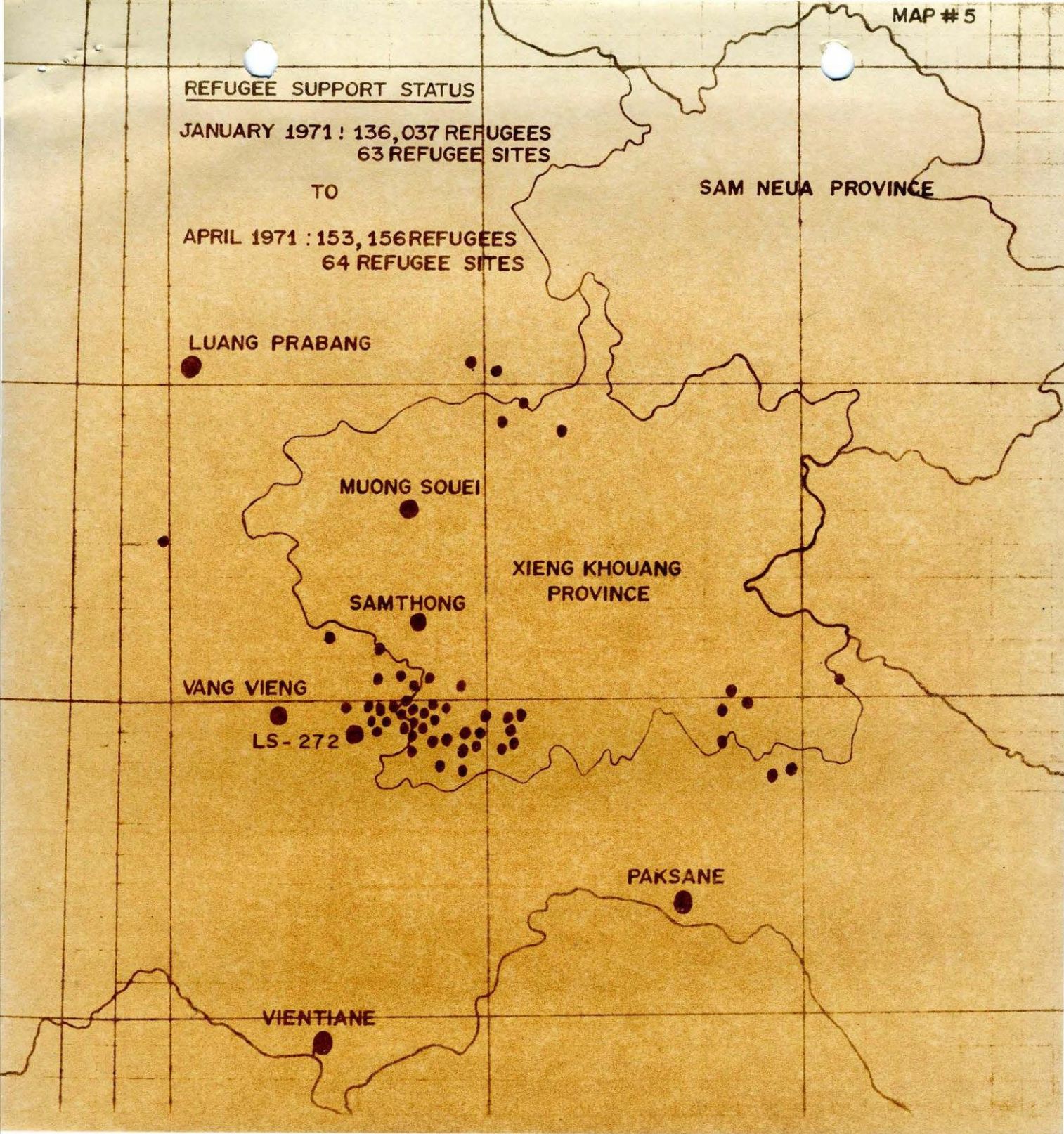

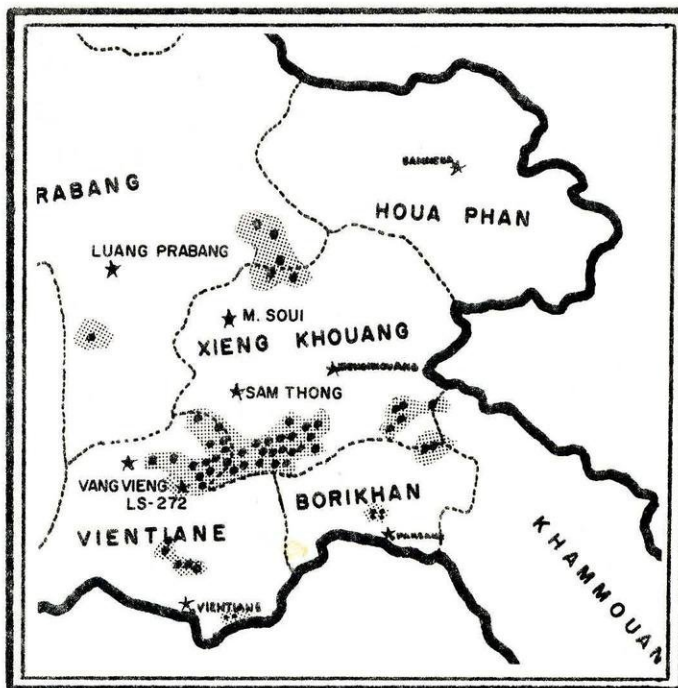

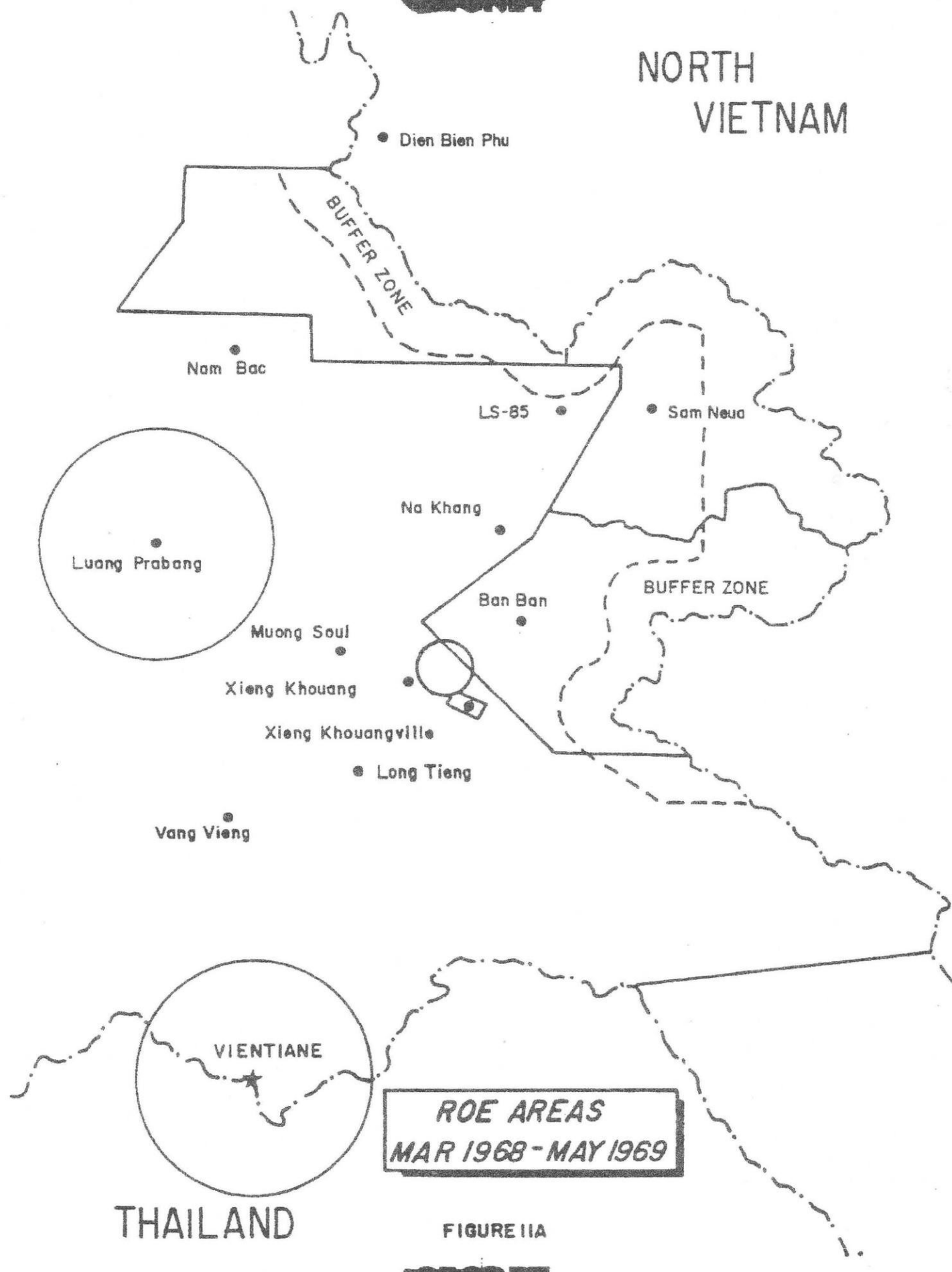
