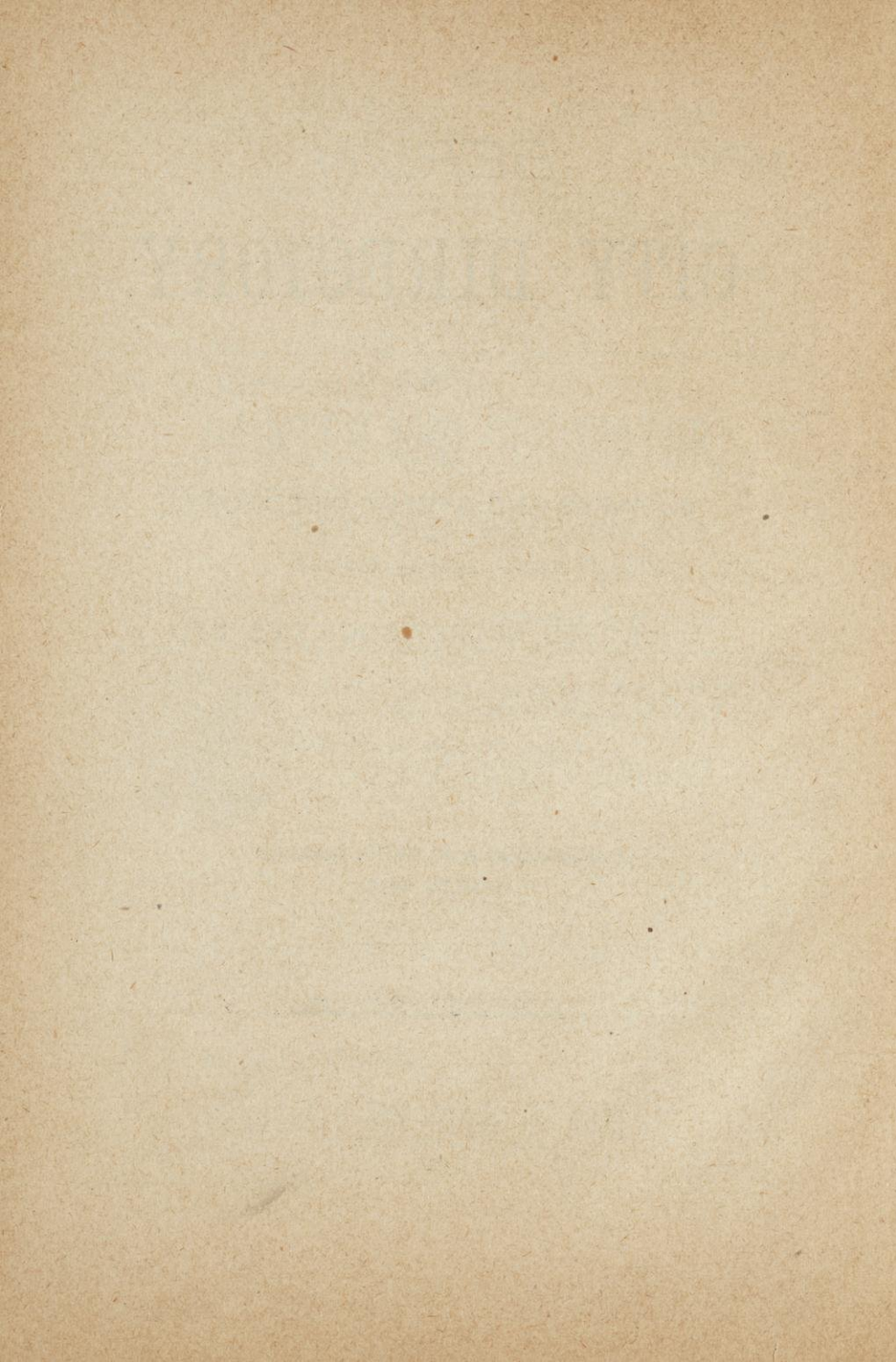

STREETS.

STREET NUMBERS.

Every space of twenty-two linear feet frontage of lots or parts of lots on any street in the city of Berlin should be numbered with a separate number and known thereby as follows: the number on all streets running north and south commence at the southern limits and run north; on all streets running east and west, commence at the river and run towards the west on the west side, and towards the east on the east side. One hundred numbers being assigned to the length of a block so that the first number in the block should be 100, the second block 200, etc. The odd numbers are assigned to the northern and western sides of the streets, and even numbers to the opposite sides.

STREET DIRECTORY.

Adams ave. is the 7th street east of river, runs north to Moore st. and south to river.

- Arnold st. is the 14th street west of river, runs 4 blocks south from W. Ceresco st.
- Bates st. is the 12th st. east of river, is the north extension of Leffert st.

- Broadway is the continuation of Huron st., runs west from river to city limits.
- Brooklyn st. is 4th street west of river, runs north $1\frac{1}{2}$ blocks and south to VanHorn st.
- Canal st. is 3d st. south of Broadway, runs west from river to Washington st.
- Capron st. is 4th street east of river, runs north from Huron to Marquette st. and south from Huron st. to river.
- Center st. is 15th street east of river, runs north to Marquette st. and south 2 blocks.
- Chase st. is 9th street west of river, runs south between Vliet and VanHorn sts.
- Church st. is 10th street east of river, runs north to Park ave. and south to South st.
- Commercial st. is 1st street west of river, runs south from Broadway to W. Ceresco st.
- Cottage st. is 6th street north of Broadway, runs west from the river to Kossuth st.
- Creek st. is 8th street south of Huron st., runs $1\frac{1}{2}$ blocks west from Dartford st.
- Dartford st. is 18th street east of river, runs south from Ripon road to limits.
- Division st. is 6th street south of Broadway, runs west from Mound to Washington st.
- Dock st, is first street north of Broadway, next to river, runs 1 block southeast from Webster st.
- Dwight st. is 7th street west of river, runs south between Vliet and VanHorn sts.
- E. Ceresco st. is 2d street south of Huron st., runs east from river to Spring st.
- E. Cumberland st. is 8th street north of Huron st., runs east

- from river to Wisconsin st., skips 1 block, runs east from Spring to Sacramento st.
- E. Franklin st. is 1st street south of Huron st., runs east from river to Adams ave.
- Edwards st. is the south continuation of Sacramento st., runs south from Ripon road to Creek st.
- Elm st. is 2d street north of Broadway, runs west from Washington to Smith st.
- Forest st. is 1st street south of Broadway, runs west from Washington to Julia st.
- Fox Alley is between Capron and Pearl sts., runs north and south between E. Ceresco st. and Park ave.
- Frontier st. is 3d street east of river, runs north from Noyes to Marquette st.
- Greeley st. is 14th street east of river, runs north from Moore st. to E. Cumberland st.
- Greenwood st. is 16th street east of river, runs north from Noyes to Marquette st.
- Grove st. is 5th street west of river, runs south to VanHorn st. north $1\frac{1}{2}$ blocks, and continues north between Cottage and W. Cumberland sts.
- Harrison st. is 10th street west of river, runs north 2 blocks from Seward to W. Cumberland st.
- Hunter st. is 16th street west of river, runs along western boundary of limits north and south of Broadway.
- Huron st. begins at the bridge, runs east to city limits.
- Jackson st. is 7th street west of river, runs north from Broadway to W. Cumberland st.
- Jefferson st. is 9th street west of river, runs north from Broadway to Seward St.
- Johnson st. is 14th street east of river, runs south to South st. and north to Noyes st.
- Julia st. is 10th street west of river, runs south between Vliet and VanHorn sts.
- Junction st. is 3rd street south of Huron, runs east from Ripon road to Johnson st.
- June st. is 5th street south of Huron and is a continuation of River st., runs east from State to Johnson st.

- Kossuth st. is 11th street west of river, runs north to W. Cumberland st. and south to W. Ceresco st.
- La Fayette st. is 4th street north of Broadway, runs west from Washington to Kossuth st.
- Leffert st. is 12th street east of river, runs south from Huron to South st.
- Liberty st. is 4th street north of Huron st., runs east from river to Center st.
- Maple ave. is a continuation of Noyes st., from Spring to State st.
- May st. is 7th street north of Huron st., runs 1 block east from Spring st.
- Marquette st. is 6th street north of Huron st., runs from river east to Wisconsin st., skips 1 block, continues east from Spring st. 2 blocks, skips 1 block, continues east from Center st. to limits.
- McKittrick st. is 15th street west of river, runs south between Broadway and Van Horn st.
- Mill st. is 2d west of river, runs north from Broadway to Dock st.
- Monroe st. is 3d st. north of Broadway, runs west from Washington to Kossuth st.
- Moore st. is 3d st. north of Huron st., runs east from river to Center st.
- Morris st. is 8th st. west of river, runs south from Van Horn to Dock st.
- Mound st. is 3rd st. west of river, runs south from Broadway to Van Horn st.
- Noyes st. is 2d st. north of Huron st., runs east from river to Wisconsin st., skips 3 blocks, continues east from Sumner to Rock st.
- Orton st. is continuation of Center st., runs north from E. Cumberland to Waushara st.
- Park ave. is 1st st. north of Huron st., runs east from river to cemetery.
- Pearl st. is 5th st. east of river, runs north to Moore st. and south to river.
- Pierce st. is 2d st. west of river, runs south from Broadway

- to Canal st.
- Railroad st. is 5th st. south of Broadway, runs west from Washington to Chase st.
- Reese st. is 12th st. west of river, runs north 3 blocks from Broadway.
- Ripon Road runs from Spring st., 1 block south of Huron st., south-east to limits.
- River st. is 5th st. south of Huron st., runs east from Capron to State st.
- Rural st. is 7th st. north of Broadway, runs west from Washington st. to limits.
- Rush Lake Road is 7th st. south of Huron st., runs east from Ripon Road to limits.
- Sacramento st. is 17th st. east of river, runs north from E. Cumberland to Waushara st.
- Seward st. is 5th st. north of Broadway, runs west from Washington to Kossuth st.
- Smith st. is 13th st. west of river, runs north 3 blocks from Broadway.
- South st. is 6th south of Huron st., runs east from river to Johnson st.

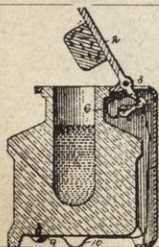

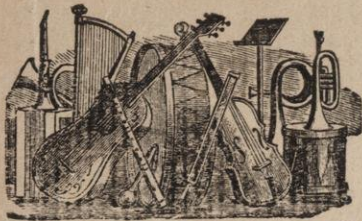


