RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE BUSINESS MANAGER

- 1. That authority be requested from the governor for the purchase of a truck for the department of buildings and grounds at an estimated cost of \$1,500; chargeable to 20.41 (1)(d). Adopted.
 - 2. That authority be requested from the governor for the purchase of a truck for the animal husbandry department at an estimated cost of \$670; one-half chargeable to 20.41 (8)(B) Gifts, Wisconsin Manufacturers' Association, and one-half to 20.41(3)(K), Dairy and Farm Sales.

 Adopted.
 - 3. That the following transfers be made:
 - \$600 from Adm. & Gen. Unassigned to School of Music, Special Grants, 20.41(1)(a). (To take care of band for commencement.)
 - 500 from L & S Unassigned to L & S Equipment Repairs, 20.41(1)(a). (To take care of work requested by the Industrial Commission in Bascom Theatre).
 - 100 from Regents' Unassigned to Adm. & Gen. Lectures, 20.41 (1)(a).
 - 1,500 from Printing & Publishing to Postage, Adm. & Gen., 20.41(1)(a). (Registrar's Office).
 - 1,400 from Travel to General Supplies, Adm. & Gen., 20.41 (1)(a).
 - 200 from Regents' Unassigned to Letters and Science assistance for Dr. Dawson in Experimental College.

Adopted.

4. That \$680 be transferred from 20.41 (3)(k) to 20.41 (1)(a) to provide for an adjustment in the work of Professors Hastings and Fred.

Adopted.

5. That the gift of Professor Ray S. Owen of a used seven-passenger Buick car, 1915 model, D55, for use at Devils' Lake Camp, be accepted.

Adopted.

The Business Manager made verbal report with reference to the status of the Memorial Union equipment and the arrangements for a loan on the proposed Field House.
