Where the drinking water supply contains less than 0.7 parts per million of fluoride, supplementary fluoride is indicated for the formation and development of caries-resistant teeth.

"Since it appears that dietary fluoride provides its greatest benefit during the period of tooth development, one may assume that the child should receive adequate fluoride from infancy until at least 12 to 14 years of age."* Each ml of Pediaflor provides 0.5 mg fluoride as sodium fluoride.†

The dosage of Pediaflor is usually ½ ml to 2 ml per day depending on the fluoride content of the drinking water supply, and as directed by physician.

Precautions: Should not be used where the drinking water supply contains more than 0.7 parts per million of fluoride. Do not exceed recommended dosage; excessive

intake of fluoride may cause gastrointestinal distress or fluorosis. Hypersensitive persons may manifest eczema, atopic dermatitis or urticaria.

Caution: Federal (U.S.A.) law prohibits dispensing without a prescription.

Supply: 30 ml bottles with dropper calibrated at ¼ ml, ½ ml, ¾ ml and 1 ml.
