



All of the equipment required in the sewing room is condensed into this one unit. Facilities for sewing, pressing, cutting, pattern design and layout, and related activities are provided as is shown by the illustrations on this page. It is an excellent study table as illustrated in the lower right hand corner. There are storage compartments for pressing iron, pressboard, tote trays and books. Electrical outlets are provided and cutouts will be made for any make, or model, of sewing machine.


The unit is made of hard maple and is available in colors as shown on the color chart insert. Tops regularly furnished are seven ply maple veneer wth a natural maple finish. Other tops, including suede finish Formica (no glare and no slip) are available at a nominal change in price.

Machine heads recessed and cutting top extended. Overall working area 90" long x 64" wide. Ample space for high school and college activity.









42H707 WALL SEWING UNIT

This individual sewing unit provides a pull-out sewing machine cabinet with folding extension leaf. A battery of these installed along window wall makes an ideal sewing area. Long counter may be used for cutting, or other work. Space between machines may have tote tray compartments and/or drawer. Cabinet size is $18\frac{1}{4}$ " wide x 30" deep x $28\frac{3}{4}$ " high (30" with top).

Machine unit extends 27" when pulled out, and leaf extends another 15", or 42" overall. Top may be plastic, linoleum or maple, (see page 21). Top should be not less than 30" deep. Specify type of apron rail to be used between units. Cut out is provided for any make of sewing machine. State make and model number of machine to be used.





TYPICAL BASE UNITS

Typical examples of the Hamilton Base Unit line are shown on this and the following page. See pages 21 thru 24 for line drawings, dimensions and details of the large variety of cabinets offered. All units are constructed of northern hard maple. Drawers have hardboard bottoms, polyethylene safety stops and satin finished chrome plated pulls. Units are finished in any of the beautiful pastel stains shown on the color chart insert.



DRAWER UNITS

Made in several widths and heights, with both shallow and deep drawers. For storage of cutlery, small utensils, linens and other items. Cutlery and utensil trays are shown on page 20.



Available in single and double door cabinets in five widths and two heights. Shelves are adjustable and may be removed if full height storage is desired. See pages 21 and 22 . . .



CUPBOARD UNITS

Also made with two shallow drawers and cupboard and with one deep drawer, two shallow drawers and cupboard. Available in five widths and two heights. See pages 21 and 22. Shelves are adjustable.




SLIDE-OUT SHELF UNITS

These units, with work levels at 36" and 29" heights, provide a lower work surface for shorter students; for using a mixer; for rolling out pastry; as a planning desk or table for two. Pull-outtable is solid maple on substantial wood extensions. Two widths, see page 23.



OPEN SHELF UNITS

Splendid for storage of student's books and purses during classes. Installed in multiples they provide storage and easy access to common reference materials. May be used as bookcases. Other open shelf units, both base and wall type, are shown on pages 24 and 26 thru 28.



BUILT-IN RANGE UNITS


For any size built-in gas or electric range. Specify make and model number of range so that proper top, (and front frame if necessary) cutouts can be made. Cupboard has an adjustable shelf. Three widths, see page 23. Built-in oven units are shown on pages 15 and 34.

Angle corner units utilize otherwise wasted corner space, and make it possible for students to work at adjoining cabinets without interfering with each other. They are made in rotary or stationary shelf models, and sink units.


The rotary unit includes two full circle, raised edge, coppertone finish metal shelves, which are adjust-

able in height. A full height formed shield prevents articles from falling off of shelves. Doors are lipped on all four edges making unit dust tight. This is an important feature — "pie cut" type units, with doors that revolve within cabinet, cannot be made dust tight.

The stationary shelf type is equipped with a floor and one adjustable shelf for storage of bulky utensils and grocery items. The sink units are designed for both single and double bowl sink installations, using either stainless steel or enameled cast iron sinks. See pages 23 and 24 for dimensional details. 



PLAN 1. FOODS ROOM

PLAN 2. 24-STUDENT CLOTHING ROOM






