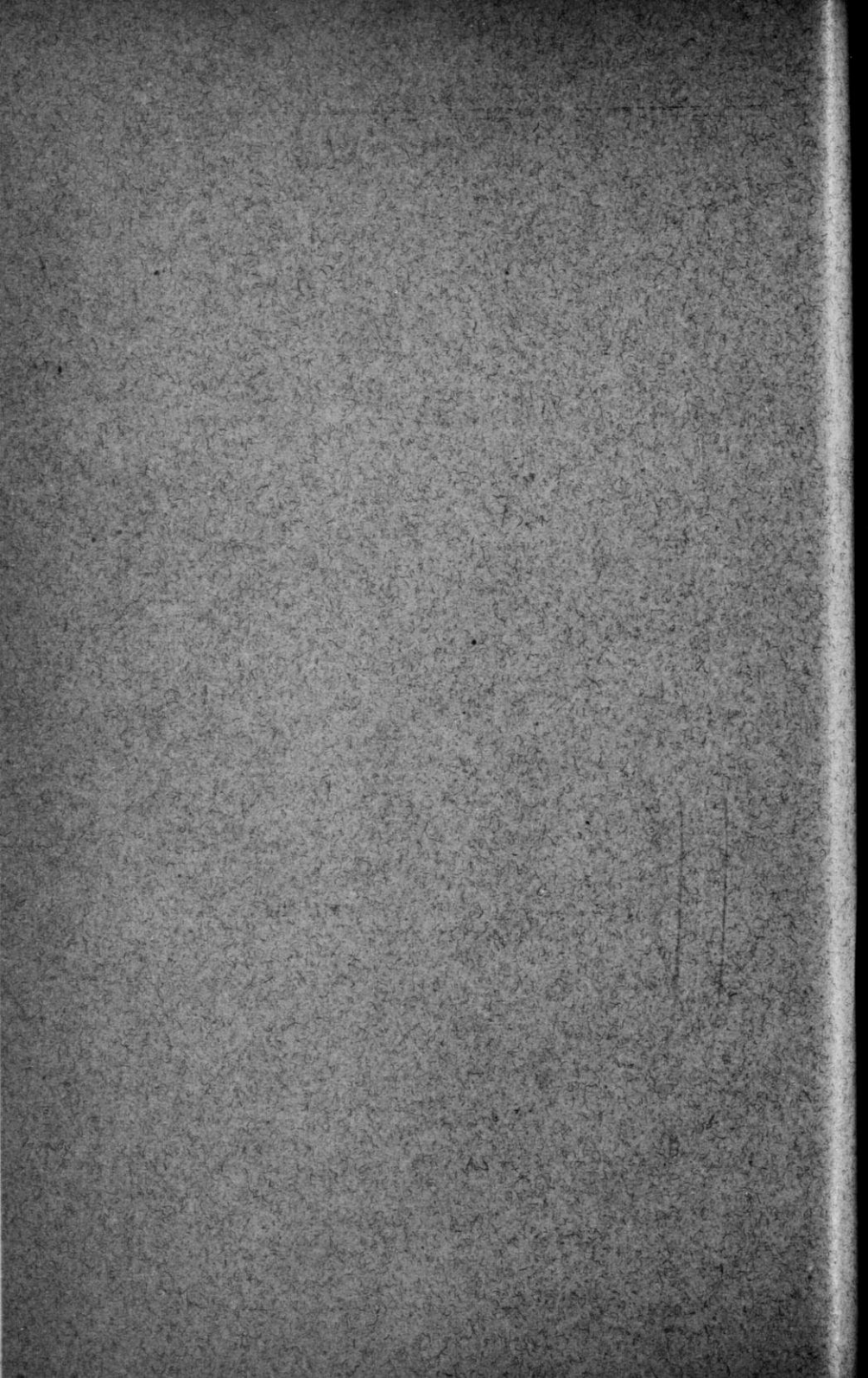

DEAR SIR: We have the honor to submit herewith, as required by law, our report of transactions of this department for the biennial term ended June 30, 1912. Exhibits A to H, inclusive, are intended to convey all the information as to the work of the office that can be embodied within the fifty pages allowed for our report.

Land sales have been stimulated by the liberal provisions of chapter 452, laws of 1911, but how far it will promote improvement and settlement of the lands cannot be determined until completion of contracts, when claims for credits in accordance with the law are submitted. The law not providing for actual occupancy of lands sold, we have no means of knowing what portion have been taken for homes, but, from knowledge of the persons purchasing, we judge the amount to be very small. Of the 58,536 acres sold during the biennial term of this report, 11,200 acres have been sold on contract under terms of chapter 452, laws of 1911. The remainder, 47,336 acres, have been sold for cash. Large purchases of land for additions to state forest reserve, as authorized by law, account for the fact that the total acreage of lands held by the state is nearly 20,000 acres more at this date than on June 30, 1910.

*General Report.*

---

Especial attention is invited to the matter of loans from trust funds to school districts and investment in bonds of and loans to municipalities of the state. Demands for such investment of funds exceed the amount available from year to year. Changes in the law, limiting amount that may be loaned to or invested in bonds of a city or county, and increasing the minimum rate of interest (which is now  $3\frac{1}{2}$  per cent) for funds that may be invested in loans or on bonds of cities or counties, seems to us advisable.

The statement of receipts credited to the various funds through this department, as epitomized in Exhibit F1 and F2, faintly portrays the volume and importance of the work connected therewith. The aggregate of \$1,246,921.75 for the two years represents many thousands of items, ranging from a few cents to thousands of dollars.

All work in the office has been done by two clerks and a stenographer, but to accomplish it they have been required to work much more than the regulation hours. The appropriation of \$500 per year for clerical help, in addition to fixed salaries, under chapter 527, laws of 1909, is insufficient. During the past year we have found it necessary to ask for additional help under paragraph 2, section 169b, laws of 1911. The appropriation for clerical help, in addition to fixed salaries, should, in our judgment, be increased from \$500 to \$1,000 per year.
