Great names in Anaesthetics

SPINAL "D"

A hyperbaric solution of amethocaine hydrochloride for inducing spinal anaesthesia below the level of the diaphragm.

Supplied in 3 cc. ampoules containing 1% (30 mgm.) of amethocaine hydrochloride. Boxes of 6 and 50.

REGIONAL "D"

Consists of dry amethocaine hydrochloride for use with normal saline. Indicated for abdominal field block, brachial plexus block, epidural block, etc.

Supplied in sterile ampoules containing 100 mgm. of amethocaine hydrochloride. Boxes of 6 and 50.

SPINAL "D" (ISOTONIC)

A prolonged-action spinal least likely to be followed by post-operative complications. Isotonic with the C.S.F., its specific gravity eliminates the risk of upward spread.

Supplied in 5 cc. ampoules containing 0.4% of amethocaine hydrochloride (20 mgm.) Boxes of 6.
