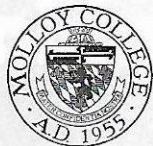
CHAIRPERSON DEPARTMENT OF NURSING

Nursing degree programs are fully accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education and attract a culturally diverse student population. Candidates must possess an earned doctorate in nursing or an allied field and a master's degree in nursing. Active involvement in research or scholarly activities and professional achievements should warrant appointment to the rank of Associate Professor or higher. The candidate must be eligible for professional licensure in New York State.

Preferred qualities include a strong clinical practice background, significant experience in curriculum development, and active involvement in professional organizations. Excellent communication skills and commitment to community service are also desired, as is a collegial leadership style that fosters cooperation and professional development within a diverse population.
