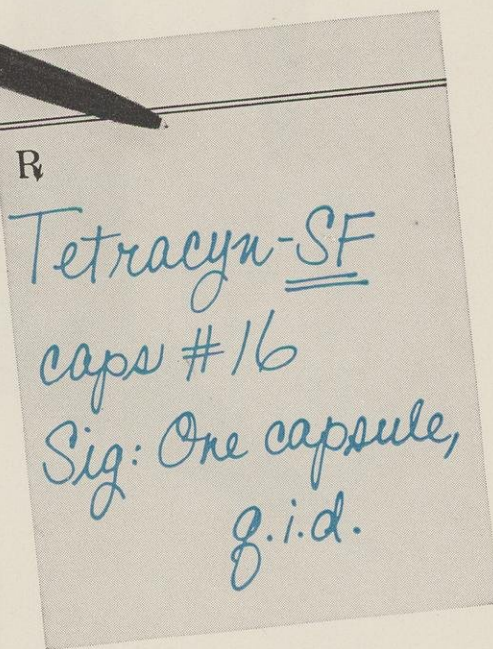

The minimum daily dose of each antibiotic (1 Gm. of Terramycin or Tetracyn, or 600,000 units of penicillin) Stress Fortifies the patient with the stress vitamin formula recommended by the National Research Council:

Ascorbic acid, U.S.P.	300 mg.	Calcium pantothenate	20 mg.
Thiamine mononitrate	10 mg.	Vitamin B ₁₂ activity	4 mcg.
Riboflavin	10 mg.	Folic acid	1.5 mg.
Niacinamide	100 mg.	Menadione	
Pyridoxine hydrochloride	2 mg.	(vitamin K analog)	2 mg.
