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




From August 22 to

Most of the houses
were burnt down,
The towns and villages
having suffered
greatly from the
bombardment.

The inhabitants
obliged to fly precipitately
could only take with

quickly piled on
carts, the children
sitting on the top
of them. One
cattle had to be
left behind and
was all taken by
the enemy.


They could not
take with them
any provisions, and



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starved during a few days. Some of them found shelter at some friend's houses far off, others were hospitalized in empty schools, hundreds piled up in a small space.

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


Conclusion




