

To keep pace with advancements in total knee surgery, we've added the Zimmer Knee Exerciser to our traction system.

This splint system was designed specifically for facilitating knee exercises following a total knee procedure. It also eliminates pressure on the ischium, and distributes weight evenly for patient comfort.

The operative leg and the Knee Exerciser are placed in balanced suspension. A cord, attached to the end of the Pearson Attachment, is secured to the bed frame near the head of the bed. The patient is then able to passively exercise his knee by moving this cord.


