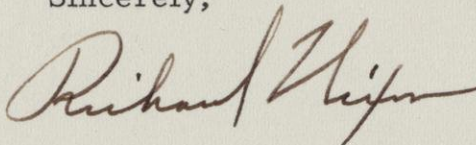
Dear Mr. Niederkorn:
