## COMMENTS

We considered the quality of work submitted to be of a high caliber. We attempted to select an all-around show representing the work artists in the State of Wisconsin are producing. Not any one school was favored. We felt more sculpture should be encouraged. However, we were very pleased with the prints which were entered and think this is a fine show for the middlewest.

# STATISTICS

173 artists submitted 288 works of art in oil and tempera, water-color, pastel, sculpture, and graphics, with a limit of two entries per person.

100 works were selected by the jury for exhibition in the Salon. Represented in this selection are the works of 79 Wisconsin artists.

The contributors who were eligible have had three years' residence in Wisconsin including the past year, or were ten-year residents in Wisconsin if now living outside of the state, or are faculty or students now in Wisconsin art schools.
