Dear Sir

Yours of the 31st received,
I thank you for your notice in due form,
that you are all right and
can, if the people will permit
you, go ahead.

School District No. 5 of the town of Easthampton
County of Suffolk, is hereby authorized
to raise by tax for the purpose of
building a new school-house,
such sum of money, exceeding
\$1000 as a majority of the legal voters
in said district duly called,
shall deem proper.
