Articles of agreement made between John P. Osborn
Superintendent of the Montauk Lighthouse on behalf of the
United States and Felix Downing of East Hampton County
of Suffolk and State of New York Copper Smith as follows
that is to say —

That the said Felix Downing doth by these
presents promise, Contract, Covenant, and agree with the said
John P. Osborn to remove the copper from the Dome of the said
Montauk Lighthouse and cover the said dome with thirty two
ounce copper and furnish all the materials necessary for
said work and paint the dome with a good and substantial
coat of paint — The said Felix Downing hereby promises
contracts, and agrees to replace any work that he may injure
in and about the said Lighthouse and to have all the above
mentioned work executed and completed in a neat, faithful
and workmanlike manner on or before the first day of
July next for the sum of Two hundred & thirty Dollars —

All of the said work shall be done and executed
under the superintendance and to the approbation of the said
John P. Osborn or such person or agent as he shall appoint
to inspect the said work —

The said John P. Osborn on his part doth
covenant, promise, Contract, and agree to pay the said
Felix Downing on his faithfully executing and completing
the above work as specified in this contract and agreeable
to directions the above mentioned sum of Two hundred
& thirty Dollars in behalf of the part of the United States
and the old copper that is now on the said Lighthouse —

In Witness whereof and for the faithful performance
of the same the contracting parties have hereunto set their hands
and seals at Sag Harbor this Sixth day of June One thousand
eight hundred and thirty three —
