Sir,
 You will receive enclosed a transfer from the
 Sac Fox and Wabasha's Band of Sioux Indians of the reserved
 interest of those Indians to the strip of Country lying between
 the Western boundary line of the State of Missouri and the
 Missouri River. The form of the enclosed convention, which has
 been signed by these Indians, was enclosed to me by General
 William Clark, Superintendent of Indian Affairs at St. Louis,
 a copy of which has been enclosed to Major Tatnall, U. S.
 Indian Agent for the upper bands of Sioux Indians for their
 signatures. That gentleman, in answer to my communication to him
 on that subject, states that he had paid the upper bands of
 Sioux their annuity money before the receipt of my letter, and
 that he feared it would be somewhat difficult to convince these
 Indians, as they had started on their fall hunt, but that he
 would do every thing in his power to effect a meeting of them
 in time to meet the object of the Government.
