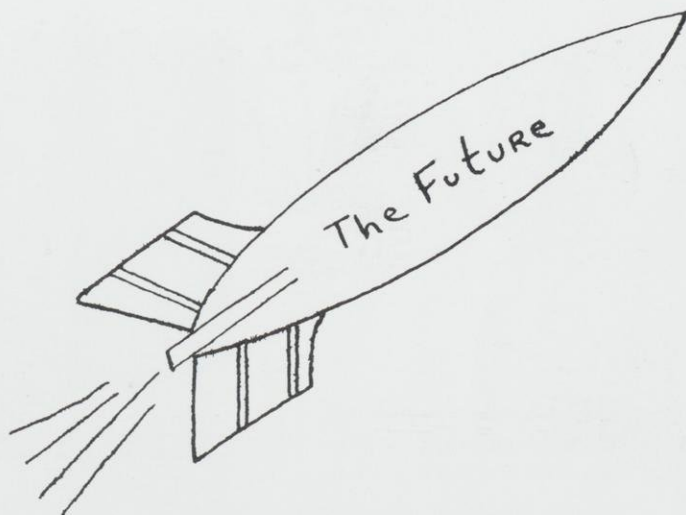


CLIFFORD EASTMAN
