




Lake Michigan Trips

TO MICHIGAN AND WISCONSIN

THE many summer resorts on Lake Michigan and Green Bay, reached by the Goodrich Lines, are all very popular, and the trips to and from these resorts by water make an added attraction to the vacationist.

The steamers on the Mackinac Route make many stops along the Wisconsin shore,

and the delightful trip through beautiful Green Bay, stopping at Sturgeon Bay, Fish Creek, Ephraim, Sister Bay and Washington Island, affords many interesting views of the scenic features of this region. Mackinac Island is situated in the Straits of Mackinac, between Lake Michigan and Lake Huron, with Lake Superior a few miles to the north. The main plateau is about one hundred and fifty feet above the level of the lake, and this island played a very important part in the early history of the Northwest. Visitors have been attracted to Mackinac Island by its many interesting and healthful features, and thousands of tourists return yearly for their summer vacations.

The Goodrich Service offers several one-day and two-day trips to the vacationist who desires only a short lake outing and also for the resorter who desires to take week-end vacations.
