

## WHY SHOULD AMRC BE CLOSED?

The Army Mathematics Research Center has hastened throughout the years of anti-war activities to project the image of being a "pure" research center, not significantly different from other parts of the University. However, the Army does not support AMRC for "pure" research; instead, AMRC exists for its contributions to Army weapons and strategy. The administration and faculty at the University of Wisconsin-Madison have cooperated in the attempts to spread a false public image of AMRC. The fact is that AMRC has involved itself in research on every major category of Army weapons and strategy over the past fifteen years. The Center's involvement with the military is illustrated by its contributions to counter-insurgency research at Project Michigan and the Strategy and Tactics Analysis Group, to chemical and biological war fare and to conventional weapons research.

Think tanks like the Army Mathematics Research Center give the Government the tools to exploit and kill people around the world in Indochina, Northern

Ireland, Phillipines, Chile and Africa.
