SECRETARY'S REPORT

January 1, 1938 to January 1, 1939

The Board of Directors of the Association outlined a program designed to cooperate with all existing agencies, the College of Agriculture, Department of Agriculture and Markets, Vocational Agriculture Departments, County Agricultural Agents, Breed Associations and The Wisconsin State Fair, to increase Dairy Farm Income. To promote and encourage Bull Associations, Production Record Keeping among Vocational Agricultural Departments, Production Shows and Breeding Schools and to work in every way possible with the Junior Dairymen. To work for more record keeping and greater use of records, the Association has endeavored to cooperate fully with the above-named groups. A brief summary of activities is included in this report.

ANNUAL MEETING

The Annual Meeting was held in Eau Claire, March 31 and April 1, 1938. The General and Junior programs were attended by approximately three thousand dairy farm people.

The speakers brought to the convention to discuss the dairy farm problems were: Dean Chris. L. Christensen, University of Wisconsin; O. S. Aamodt, University of Wisconsin; E. N. Hanson, Iowa State College; Andrew Boss, University of Minnesota; J. B. Fitch, University of Minnesota; Glen Householder, Extension Director, Holstein-Friesian Association of America; J. G. Hays, Michigan State College; L. E. Casida, University of Wisconsin; Fred R. Miller, D. V. M., Whitewater, Wisconsin; Howard Greene Genesee Depot, and Ralph Ammon, Department of Agriculture and Markets.

March 31st was proclaimed by Governor Philip F. LaFollette as All-Wisconsin Dairy Day. The Dairy Feast held the first day of the convention featured dairy foods and lots of fun. Every available banquet ticket was sold and the program included Florence Merritt and her 4-H Club calf, both attending the banquet as guests of the Wisconsin Dairymen's Association.

YEAR BOOK

In connection with the annual meeting the third annual publication of the Wisconsin Dairymen's Association Year Book was distributed. Listed in this publication were the members of our association following a testing program, together with the number of cattle, their breed and whether these cattle were grade or registered. This Year Book included the secretary's annual report and a financial statement of the Association.

BULL ASSOCIATIONS

Better use of proved sires and organizations to keep sires

alive until proved have occupied time and thought of the Association. Fifty-five groups have been working toward bull association cooperatives and many more have planned some definite action on sire exchanges.

In this Year Book is a list of bull associations that have been organized long enough to have planned one sire exchange.

Artificial insemination as a part of the dairy improvement program has been assisted by the Association. Several demonstrations and discussions were given and two groups have been given assistance in organization and sire selections.

EXHIBITS

A seven-panel exhibit showing activities and their value to Wisconsin Dairymen was used at production shows, Dairy Meetings, County Fairs, and the State Fair. This exhibit resulted in many requests for assistance in farm program planning and sire selection and use.

At the State Fair, an exhibit showing four groups of four generations each was put on with the cooperation of the College of Agriculture, D. H. I. A. Fieldmen, County Agents, Breed Associations and the James Manufacturing Company. The sixteen cows were all of desirable type and were all owned by D. H. I. A. members. State Fair officials and many others commenting on the exhibit, called it one of the best D. H. I. A. exhibits ever used there.

Ten thousand pamphlets were distributed explaining the exhibit and the value of a testing program.

SUPPLIES

Herd book covers for D. H. I. A. members have been supplied free to members of the Dairymen's Association and at cost to other D. H. I. A. members. Material for Jr. D. H. I. A. testing among Vocational Agricultural Departments, included more than 60,000 printed pieces that were sent out from the office. Every effort has been made to correlate the work of the regular and Jr. D. H. I. A. work in the state.

PRODUCTION SHOWS

Assistance in organizing, program planning and carrying out the program was given to fourteen production and breed shows of dairy cattle. A system of giving a type rating and a production rating was worked out and used at many of the 1938 production shows. No All-Wisconsin show was held this year.

APPRECIATION

The Wisconsin Dairymen's Association takes this opportunity to express their appreciation to the many groups and individuals who have made possible the program as carried on in 1938. We thank you.

4-H Clubs—4 meetings—352 attendance—425 miles.

Organization—13 meetings—115 attendance—1,935 miles.

Convention and planning—17 meetings—5,744 attendance.

Meetings of Breed Associations, etc.—30 meetings—5,023 attendance—2,753 miles.

Program conferences—75 planned with 153 cooperators—2,710 miles.

Farm visits—234 visits—contacted 317—traveled 1,552 miles.

Total meetings—212 meetings—total contacts—56,907—total miles traveled 26,940.

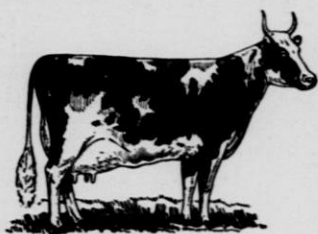

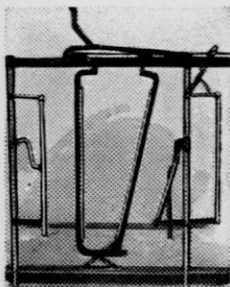

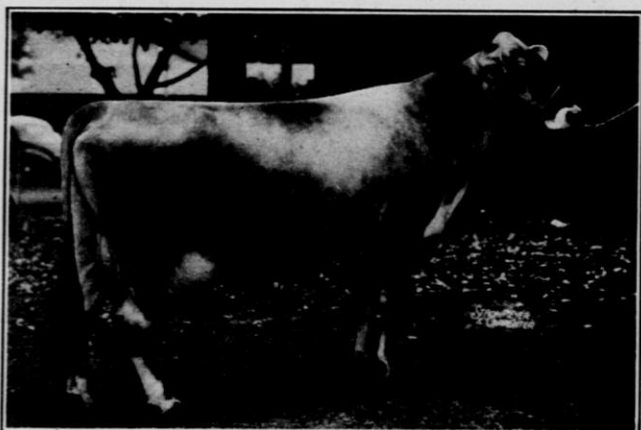

Progressive Breeders' Registry

The seed stock Holstein-Friesian herds of the state will be those able to convince prospective purchasers that their herd is free of infectious diseases, has ability to convert farm grown feeds into milk at a profit and is possessed of good dairy breed type. The Progressive Breeders' Registry, adopted in December 1938 by the Holstein-Friesian Association of America, outlines the goal for which all breeders should strive. The small farm breeder who milks his own cows can compete on even terms with the man of wealth with a salaried herdsman. The same problem faces every breeder, large and small, that of breeding more efficient Holsteins and running the herd on a sound profitable business basis.

Every Wisconsin breeder of Holstein cattle should be guiding his herd management in such a manner as to make early application for Progressive Breeders' Registry possible.

PROGRESSIVE BREEDERS' REGISTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. All animals over one year of age must be registered in our herd book.
2. At least 75% of the registered females in the herd must have been bred by applicant.
3. Every registered female must have completed an Advanced Registry record or be on test, completed records averaging not less than 480 lbs. fat in Class C or 560 lbs. in Class B or 640 lbs. in Class A, or the herd must be entered in the Herd Improvement Test and have met certain standards of production. These start with 400-lb. fat average in Class C or 480 lbs. in Class B for herds of 15 cows or less. Allowances are made for larger herds.
4. At least two-thirds of all animals in the herd that are eligible for classification must have been classified for type with an average score of not less than 80 points.
5. The herd shall be federally accredited as free from tuberculosis or be located in a modified accredited area, with a clean test within twelve months.
6. The herds shall be under state or federal supervision for control of Bang's disease, and with last test 100% clean.
7. The applicant must be a member of the Holstein-Friesian Association of America, and also of his state association.
The fee for the first certificate is \$10; annual renewals \$5 each.

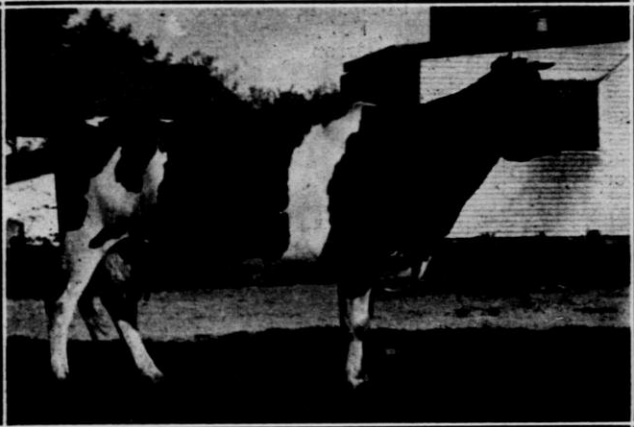

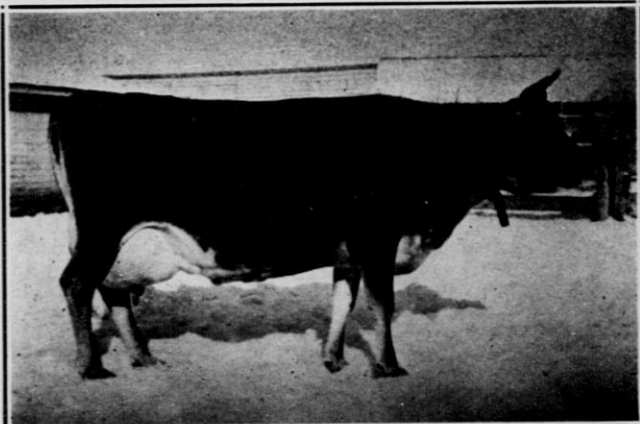

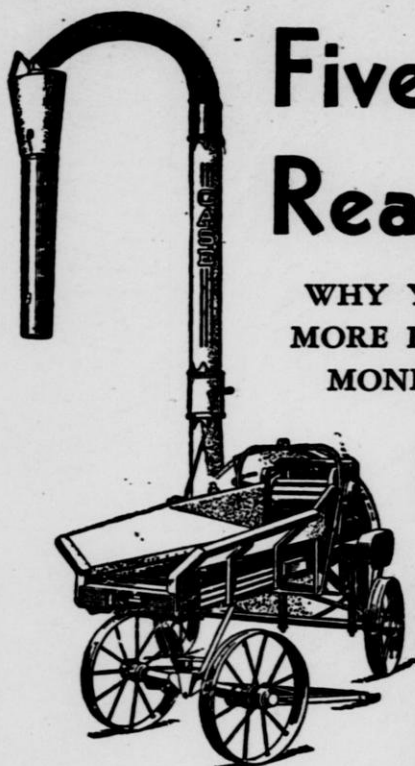
