If you are a busy pediatric health care professional who schedules activities to meet your individual needs, the National Board of Pediatric Nurse Practitioners and Associates has developed a program of continuing education for you. The program is entitled "*Self-Assessment*."

A Self-Assessment exercise consists of multiple choice questions focusing on general pediatric practice, including recent advances and designated areas of special interest. Participants answer the questions by completing an answer sheet, which may be scored if continuing education units (CEUs) are desired. Following scoring a participant may make a "Self-Assessment" of areas in which s/he may wish to pursue further study. Exploration of these areas may be directed through the question critiques and resource references provided as part of the exercise.
