



On the first day of school, I was really excited and scared at the same time. Those days, I often made mistakes opening my locker. I often tried to open the one next to mine!


Football was really a tough sport, but I liked it. After all, I couldn't get a touchdown, but it was a really good memory for me.




Registration for the 1989-90 school year began on August 14 with the senior class. The students received their schedule and got their ID pictures taken.






From left to right, Julie, Aimee, Nichole, Jodi and Camille all enjoyed a breath-taking view from the French countryside.



# A Trip To Russia




