The "Polhemus" Cabinets have all the conveniences of the Boston Cabinet, viz: Sliding case rest and galley rest combined, and in addition to this have the following *important* points in their favor. The back of the Cabinet is paneled, and compositor stands at back when setting from the top cases; the Cabinet cases pull out from the front and compositor is never disturbed by others using them, a common occurrence with other Cabinets. There is a galley rest back of the case rest, extending the whole length of the Cabinet, giving the same amount of room as a galley top cabinet; also galley shelves between the rows of cases in the double Cabinet, with room for twenty single or double galleys.



Having secured the right to manufacture the "Boson" Stands, Cabinets and Window Cabinets, we take pleasure in offering them to our patrons. The "Boston" Patent Cabinets differ from other Cabinets in having our new combined Sliding Case Rest and Galley Rest, which enables the compositor to set his galley full without leaving the stand; or, if preferred, the Galley Rest may be used to hold "pick-ups," leads, dashes, quad-lines, etc. The compositor has free access to every box in the case when correcting, and the galley is out of the way until needed.

## SIX REASONS WHY THESE CABINETS ARE THE BEST:

First — When the compositor empties his stick, the lower case is easily slid forward out of the way, exposing the galley.

Second—When correcting, the galley is not laid on the lower case, delaying the compositor, owing to half the boxes being covered, but every box in both cases is convenient of access, as is more clearly shown in cut of Window Cabinet, giving side view of the combined Sliding Case and Galley Rest.

Third—The lower case may be easily shaken up without lifting it from the stand.

Fourth—The shelf over the cases is unobstructed, and can be made useful to place live or dead matter on.

Fifth—The top cases project six inches beyond the front of the cases in the stand, so that the compositor may work easily without rubbing his knees against the cases, and may be seated, if necessary.

Sixth—The projecting case brackets save on a double stand three square feet of floor space, and when two cabinets are placed back to back the saving is six square feet.

COMBINATION CABINET ITALIC CASE AND SORT DRAWER.






FULL-SIZE CASE CABINET-GALLEY TOP.

It also prevents dust from settling on the forms and damaging the type. They are strong and accurately made to accommodate the great weight of type which is sometimes placed in them.


## INK CABINETS.

Thousands of dollars are annually lost to job printers, generally, in the single item of Ink wasted through lack of a proper place to keep the cans or jars containing the same. More particularly is this so in regard to colored or high-priced Inks not continually in use, for when placed on shelves or left lying around anywhere (if only out of the way), an estrangement often occurs between can and cover, and the Ink receives a quantity of dirt, or skins over

from exposure to the air; in either case a loss of Ink is the result. With the Ink Cabinet a place may be had for every can or jar of Ink, and with every can or jar in its place the loss of Ink from such sources would cease. The price is low enough to bring it within the means of every job office.

## HAMILTON'S CUTTING STICK FOR PAPER CUTTERS.



DESCRIPTION.—Our Cutting Stick consists of Main Body Piece A, which has a groove or recess cut the entire length of same to receive a small strip (B) 1/4 of an inch square. This removable strip is the cutting surface, and is held in place by a steel clamp C, which is drawn up by the bolts D. This removable strip being square, can be used on four sides, thus giving the same amount of cutting surface as a large sized

WE CLAIM: 1st. That the steel strip running the entire length of Main Body Piece and screwed thereto. absolutely prevents warping or springing.

2d. That there is a saving of 75 per cent. in cost of cutting sticks after the first cost of Main Body Piece, and by buying one Main Body Piece and four dozen small strips, the first cost is less than that of four dozen ordinary sticks.

3d. That the strips can be shipped by express in bundles of 100 or more at trifling cost, where one dozen of the ordinary sticks are so bulky that they must be boxed and shipped by freight.

Second, give length of stick. Third, how far from the front edge of stick does the knife strike? Fourth, is the shear of knife from right to left or from left to right in making cut. 

enable the feeder to take hold of the sheet between his thumb and forefinger and remove it quickly without smudging.

The next cut, on the left, shows the No. 1, the only difference being that this has a lip or projection




at the ends of the spring-arms to keep the sheets down. It can be used most anywhere the No. 4 can. But the No. 3, shown on the right, owing to its extreme height of curvature, will not flatten except to rise only half way up again, and this is consequently suitable only as a bottom gauge, or, when the gripper does not strike it, as a side gauge.






This will be found excellent in feeding sheets that curl and refuse to go down flat, especially where the margin of the sheet is narrow. The furniture, of course, will come in contact with No. 3, but being lower than the type will press it only part way down, in which case it will return to its original height. The dotted outline indicates the degree of descent. The ends of No. 3 are bent over to prevent rough contact, but should be used opposite an even surface in the form. The gauge pin is well balanced, both arms striking at once, so that its action does not strain it out of the tympan.

Again, while possessing all the advantages of a gauge pin in speedy and handy attachment, it may be fastened with paste by securing a square piece of paper over the flat parts and inserting one corner in a short slit made with a knife in the tympan in front of the gauge.


