East Hampton Jan^y 4th 1824

I send you the wheels all cut except the large
time piece wheel & one other, which I do not know how to cut
or how many teeth it wants the large one I fear will not
answer, not knowing what cutter to use I took the second
size, but believe it ought to be cut with the third - if you
think it will answer send it back & I will cut it, if not send
another - as to the pinion I have no cutter more being

broken
