Sir, I have the gratification to accompany this letter with the "Articles of Agreement and Convention," concluded at Miami Bay, in Michigan Territory, on the 30th ultimo, with the Ottawa Indians, residing in this State, for a cession of all the lands owned by them in Ohio, amounting to nearly 50,000 acres.

I will make another and more detailed official communication on this subject, so soon as the impaired state of my health will permit.
