Viffin, Ohio, Sept. 2? 1891. I have the gratification to accompany this letter with the Articles of Agreement and Convention, concludes at Miami Bay in Michigan Territory, on the god ultimo, with the Ottowa Indians, willing in this State, for a cepion of all the lands owner by them in Ohis, amounting to nearly 50, 000 anes. I will make another and more actailed office cial communication on this subject, so soon as the impaired state of my health will permit. I have the honor to be, wish great respect, yr. mo. ouds lens.
