This report covers the tentative decision arrived at by the Special Committee on Dormitories with other members of the Board in attendance at the meeting held Wednesday afternoon, December 6th, at the Business Manager's office. The problem is treated under the following headings:

General Plan (which includes
Legislation and Financing);
Building Program.

The report is submitted with the understanding that those participating will give the subject consideration and communicate their suggestions and criticisms to Business Manager Phillips. It is suggested that Mr. Phillips, collaborating with other members of the Committee, would establish, through the Attorney-General's office, whether this plan, revised as may be necessary, can be carried out, and then later call a meeting to give the subject further consideration.

It is assumed that at the proper time a bill will be prepared for presentation to the legislature granting to the regents full power to act on a building and financing program as outlined in the accompanying paper headed, "General Plan."

It is the desire to provide, at lowest cost, hygienic, comfortable rooms for Wisconsin students, and as this plan eliminates financing commissions and permits of our taking advantage of the lowest interest rates the saving effected will have a marked influence in lowering rentals.

GENERAL PLAN
(which includes Legislation and Financing)

A committee of three regents or officials will form a separate corporation, the membership to be represented by the fifteen members of the Board of Regents, including the ex-officio members.

The suggested name of the corporation is UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN DORMITORIES ASSOCIATION.

There is to be a stock issue of fifteen shares of no par value, one share to be in the name of each regent, including the ex-officio members.

The stock certificates are to remain in the custody of the secretary of the Board of Regents, and in order to perpetuate the control he is to be authorized to transfer each share as new appointments are made. No endorsement of the former holder is to be required, and the old shares will be automatically cancelled when new shares are issued.

The Board of Directors shall consist of fifteen regents, eight of whom shall constitute a quorum.

The officers shall be as follows:

President
Vice-President
Secretary
Treasurer

The president and secretary of the Board of Regents shall serve in like capacity. The vice-president shall be elected from among the members of the Board. The State Treasurer will act as treasurer.

All officers will serve without remuneration.

The Board of Regents are to lease the real estate to the Dormitories Ass'n for a period of twenty years. Six months before the expiration of the lease it may be renewed for a similar period in case any bonds of the first or second issues are still outstanding.

The lessors have the right to cancel the real estate lease before the expiration of any contract period if all of the mortgage bonds have been retired, in which case the real estate or chattel mortgages are to be satisfied and the property transferred to the regents.

All real estate leases are to apply only on such tracts as are specifically required for each dormitory unit.

The consideration to be specified in the lease will be nominal.

The Dormitories Ass'n will construct the buildings, which, when completed, are to be rented to and operated by the regents.

The Dormitories Ass'n will issue first mortgage bonds to the value of 50% of the building and the leasehold. These are to be eligible for investment of general and University Trust Funds.

The first mortgage bonds are to bear 5% interest, payable semi-annually, July 1st and January 1st. (If it is determined that they can be made tax exempt they will bear $4\frac{1}{2}\%$ interest.) They are to be issued for a period of twenty years and are callable after five years from date of issue, on any interest-paying date, at 102.

There will be a second mortgage bond issue equal to the balance of the cost of the building not covered by the first issue of bonds. These will be twenty year bonds, bear 6% interest payable semi-annually July 1st and January 1st, and are callable at par on any interest-paying date by giving not less than thirty days notice.

These are to be eligible for investment of University of Wisconsin Trust Funds.

None of the first mortgage bonds are to be retired until all of the second mortgage bonds have been paid.

The leasehold, buildings and contents are to be exempt from real estate and personal property taxes.

The first mortgage bond issue is to be exempt from state income taxes. (Consider federal tax question. Under the proposed plan the income from operation carried on by the state through the Board of Regents is tax exempt.)

The State Treasurer will serve as trustee and custodian of securities without compensation.

The Dormitories Ass'n will issue and sell both first and second mortgage bonds, in the order named, as building proceeds, upon presentation of architect's vouchers, up to an amount not to exceed the value of construction of each building to date.

The initial financing will be carried on by the University in the purchase of first, and, as necessary, second mortgage bonds with the University of Wisconsin Trust Funds. These bonds will be sold to the public as opportunity offers, and the second mortgage bonds only will be retained by the University as may be necessary. Both the first and second issues are to be sold at par or at a premium.

The Dormitories Ass'n will rent the buildings to the regents at a rental to cover interest and adequate depreciation to the extent permitted by the statutes.

Out of the gross earnings the regents, who are to operate the building, will pay all operation expenses including rental, maintenance and repairs.

Out of the net earnings the regents will retire a specified number of bonds annually, the cancellation to be at least equal to the annual depreciation.

The balance of net earnings shall be available to the Board of Regents for construction of new units for dormitories and dining halls as may be needed,

The furnishings are to be paid for through separate legislative appropriations.

BUILDING PROGRAM
(Preliminary outline as a guide to
State Architect.)

Site The lake front site west of the present University buildings is to be utilized.

Unit type The unit type of building is preferred.
Building

Groupings The groupings of a definite number of units are to be treated in a mass to permit of that harmony of color and architectural effect desired by the regents.

Construction To be of the type known as fire-resisting, having non-combustible floors, partitions and walls, wooden roof covered with tile or slate roofing.

Size of Unit Each unit is to be designed to house from 150 to 300 students, due consideration to be given to the size most economical to construct and operate.

It is estimated that a width of about 38 feet over all will be satisfactory; each building is not to exceed four stories in height, which includes the garret floor; basement to be in addition. Ceilings in bedrooms should not exceed eight and one-half feet in height.

The corridors at the point where the traffic is heaviest are to be eight feet in width. They can be somewhat narrower in the wings where there is less occasion for traffic congestion.

Standardized The windows should be of substantial size, and, if practicable, standardized in arrangement, which, while presenting an harmonious exterior, will permit of the adoption of either Interior Plan #1 or #2, as may be required.
Exterior

Interior
Arrange-
ment

Each unit is to have a general reception room on the main floor, and a general recreation or meeting place in the semi-basement. The lavatories and showers are to be general, adequate to meet the needs of the occupants, and to be centrally located in each wing equi-distant from stairways and exits. The lavatories are to be located in the same position on each floor, which permits of installation of plumbing at the lowest cost.

Interior
Plan No. 1

To comprise the simplest arrangement of rooms, permitting of the lowest cost with corresponding advantageous rentals to occupants.

Two floors of single rooms, size 10x14' each, closet in addition.

Two floors of double rooms, each equal to one and a half times the size of the single room, viz. 15x14', with two closets in addition.

The single and double rooms are to be used as sleeping as well as study rooms.

Interior
Plan No.2

Interior arrangement should provide for one study room, approximate size 10x14', for two occupants, and two single sleeping cubicals of approximately 7x9', each. There are to be two closets in addition in each study room.

No private lavatories or showers are to be provided with these rooms, and the same general arrangement of plumbing is to be carried out as in Interior Plan No. 1

Playing
Fields

The general layout or ground plans should show the location and area of land allotted to each dormitory unit for use as a playing field.
