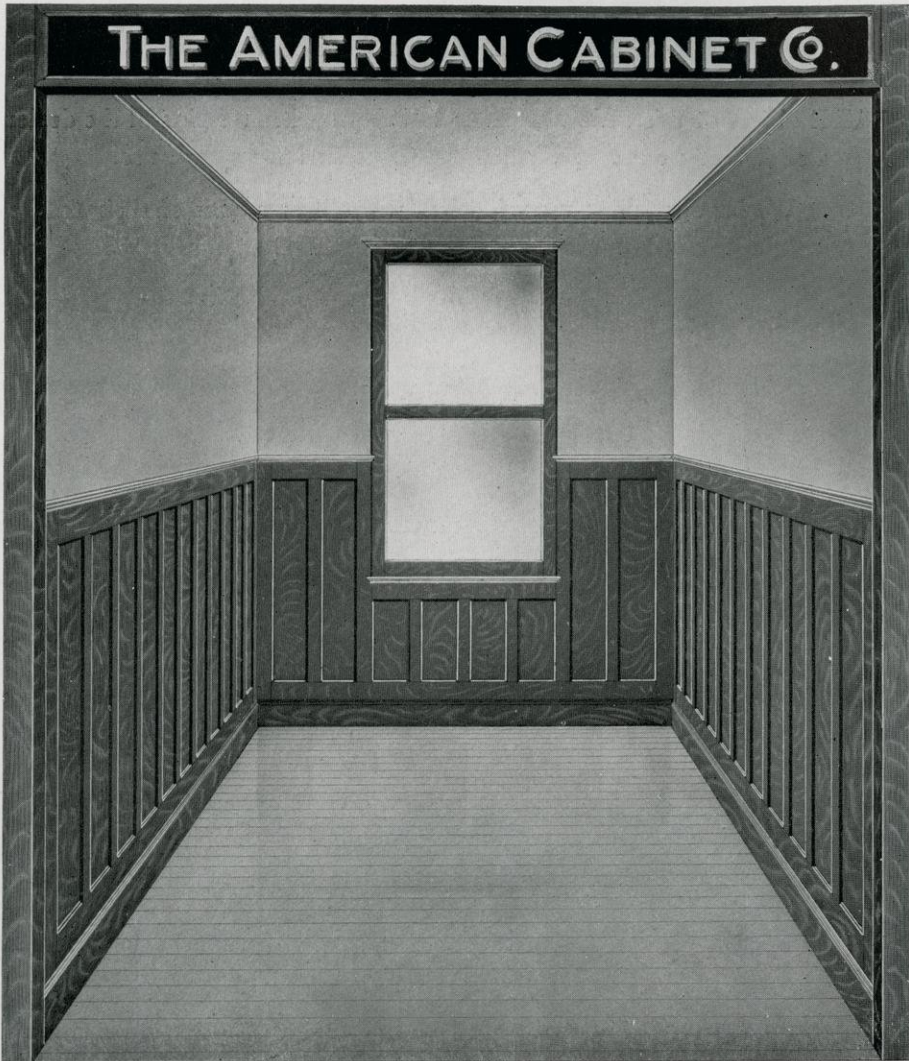

This Cabinet can be used for other purposes if desired, and every dental depot needs one.

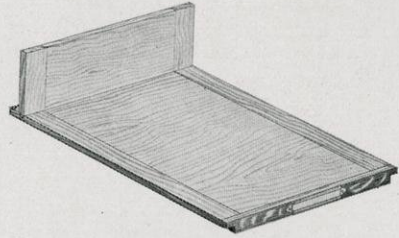
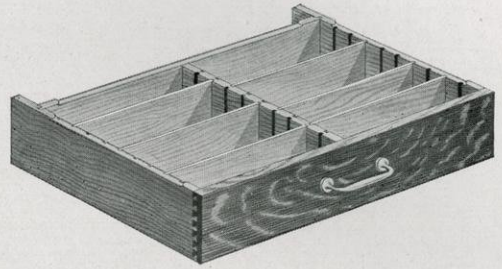
A long description is hardly necessary, as the cut shows the convenience of the Cabinet at a glance.

Catalog Cabinet

Many dealers have no regular place for manufacturers' catalogs, and as a result are often either entirely out or have many more than they need. They are also often scattered around on top of show cases or counters, and give the depot a most untidy appearance.

This Cabinet will provide a place for catalogs and circulars of all association manufacturers, and will enable you to see at a glance just the supply you have on hand of each catalog.

Each shelf is fitted with a label-holder and can be withdrawn so that even the smallest circular can be reached easily, and all shelves have a back attached that will prevent literature falling off. These shelves are all covered with a door with a glass front, which keep the catalogs free from dirt and dust.

In the base are three drawers with adjustable partitions for holding envelope slips or other small matter.

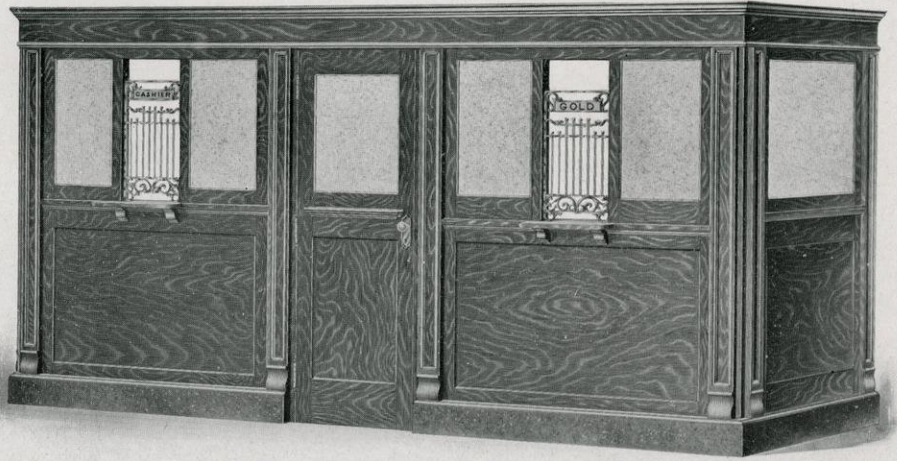
The Cabinets are thoroly well made in quarter-sawed oak or mahogany, and finished with a dull finish in any shade desired.

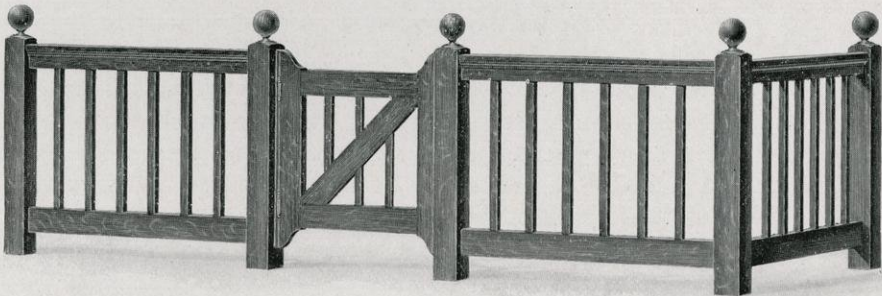

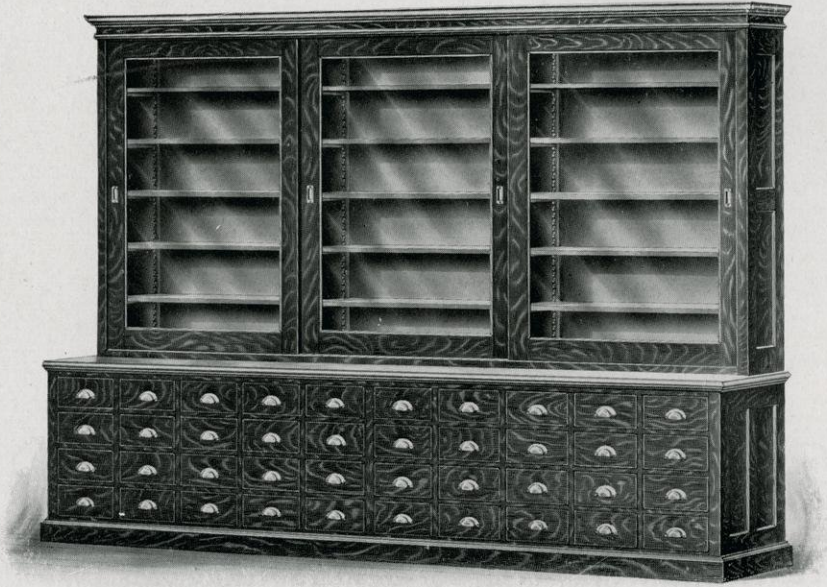
Partitions

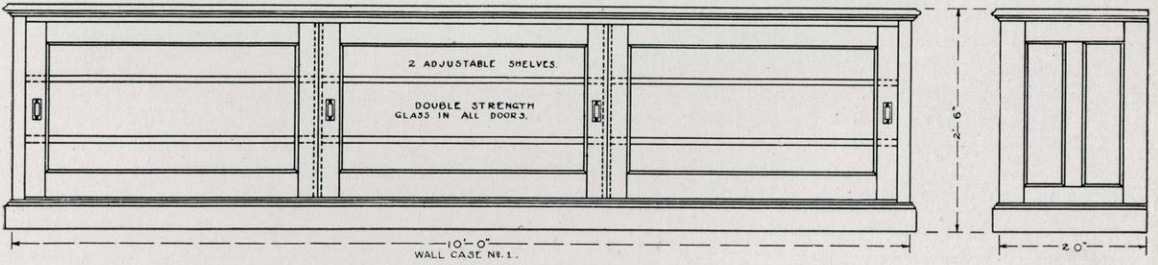
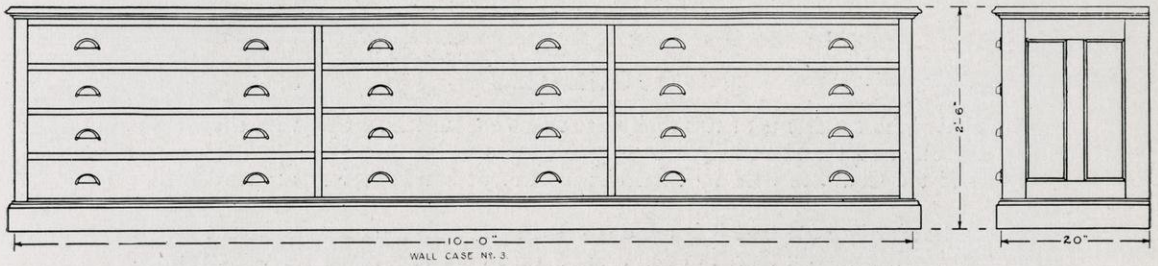
Wall Cases

The design shown is our No. 2 and has been often made, but it is not a stock article as it is seldom ordered the same length by any two purchasers.

The same top can be supplied on bases like those shown below, Nos. 1 and 3, or can be made of any design to best suit your requirements.

The drawers are all dovetailed, the sliding doors will never bind, and it is a serviceable piece of high grade furniture.

Regular Style Counter

Counters

We show here the fronts of two different styles of Counters. One with show case built on and the other of the right height to take a show case.

Most of the Counters used by the Edwards Co., at San Francisco, are made with show cases built on.

It can be readily seen that it is more convenient to pull the drawers from the rear and bring anything before you than to open a show case door and reach for what you may be in need of.

We also show you 15 different back views of Counters.

All of these plans have been suggested and are in use by dental dealers.

Those intended for show cases are usually built 3 feet high, while the others are about 3' 6" and they are as a rule ordered in 8 or 9-foot lengths.

Notice that all are made with a toe space, the drawers are dovetailed and are fitted with three-ply bottoms, the sliding doors run on ball bearings, and will not bind, label-holder pulls are used in most cases, and from start to finish they are well built pieces of cabinet work.

We have been especially favored by the dealer with orders for Tooth Counters and Cabinets. The cases in these Tooth Counters are made with three-ply bottoms and slide on steel runs. Label-holders are fitted to each case on a slanting block so they can be more readily seen. They can also be numbered both on Case and Counter if desired.



Counter with Show Case Built On

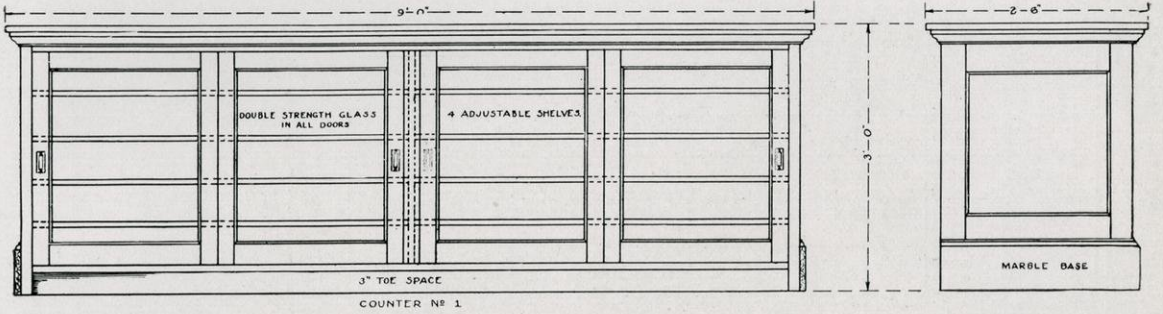

In ordering care should be taken to specify cap and base pieces, if wanted, as they are not included with order for units unless especially mentioned.

- Style M Unit has 10 cases for teeth. The inside dimensions of cases are $21\frac{3}{4}$ in. wide, 16 in. long and 9-16 in. deep. Dimensions of Unit are 24 15-16 in. wide, 20 in. deep and $10\frac{7}{8}$ in. high. Each case is divided by a center partition and contains space for 8 boxes of teeth, laid side by side. We will partition these cases differently when requested to do so, without extra charge.....\$12.00
- Style N Unit has three drawers running full width of section. The inside dimensions are 22 in. wide, 16 in. long and $2\frac{3}{8}$ in. deep. Dimensions of Unit are 24 15-16 in. wide, 20 in. deep and $10\frac{7}{8}$ in. high. See illustration..... 10.00
- Style O Unit has six drawers. Inside dimensions are $6\frac{3}{4}$ in. wide, $16\frac{1}{2}$ in. long and $3\frac{7}{8}$ in. deep. Dimensions of Unit are 24 15-16 in. wide, 20 in. deep and $10\frac{7}{8}$ in. high. See illustration..... 11.00
- Style P. Unit has eight drawers. Inside dimensions are $4\frac{3}{4}$ in. wide, $16\frac{1}{2}$ in. long and $3\frac{7}{8}$ in. deep. Dimensions of Unit are 24 15-16 in. wide, 20 in. deep and $10\frac{7}{8}$ in. high..... 11.50
- Style Q Unit has seven blank cases for electrotypes. Dimensions of Unit are 24 15-16 in. wide, 20 in. deep and $10\frac{7}{8}$ in. high..... 10.00
- Style R Unit has seven Indexed Electrotpe cases. (If you are in need of an up-to-date electrotpe cabinet, send for circular). Dimensions of Unit are 24 15-16 in. wide, 20 in. deep and $10\frac{7}{8}$ in. high..... 11.00
- Cap Piece S. Dimensions 24 15-16 in. wide, $3\frac{1}{4}$ in. high, and 20 in. deep. See illustration..... 2.50

Tooth Stock Cabinets

The above engraving represents an article of furniture needed by every dealer in dental supplies. We make them any size desired, either as to height or number of tiers.

The size of the drawers is usually about 20 inches long, 16 inches wide and 9-16 of an inch deep, but as the cabinets are made to order the size can be made to suit the requirements in each case. We also divide the drawers into two equal parts, as shown, or make compartments of the right size to take in an ordinary tooth box.

The drawers slide on steel runs, which enables us to get in more drawers in the same space than would be possible were wood runs used, and they also slide much more easily. The bottoms are made of three-ply veneer. Each drawer is fitted with a brass label holder. The cabinet is well built throughout and has a good rub finish.

Our prices are based on being made of Ash with a Golden Oak Finish, but will quote on any wood on application.
