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REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS
OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN

Madison, Wisconsin

Held in the President's Office

Saturday, December 12, 1953, 10 A.M.

President Werner presiding

PRESENT: Regents Arveson, Gelatt, Jones, Laird, Renk, Rennebohm, Watson, Werner.

ABSENT: Regents Steiger and Wanvig.

Regent Steiger was present for committee meetings on Friday.

Upon motion of Regent Watson, seconded by Regent Renk, it was
VOTED, That the minutes of the postponed regular meeting of the Board
held on November 14, 1953, be approved as sent out to the Regents.

Dr. William S. Middleton, Dean of the Medical School, appeared before the
Board on the invitation of President Fred.

Dean Middleton expressed his appreciation for the opportunity to report
to the Regents on the stewardship of the Medical School administration and to dis-
cuss the work and some of the problems of the Medical School. He stated that the
primary function of the Medical School is the training and education of physicians.
Enrollment of first year students presently is limited to about 80 per year by
reason of lack of adequate facilities. Not more than 5% of the number admitted may
be non-residents of Wisconsin. These limitations require very careful screening of
all applicants and only those of high academic achievement can be considered.
About 60% of the students come from families with annual incomes of less than \$7500.
The annual cost to each student of attending school is in excess of \$1500. About
40% of the medical students are at least partially self-supporting. Many of them

find it necessary to work part-time during the regular school year in addition to their summer and vacation employment. About 35% are in debt on completion of their medical education. The need for additional financial help for medical students is apparent.

Dean Middleton reported that 324 students are registered in the Medical School and 1591 have been graduated since the four-year medical course was established in 1927. In addition 1204 Medical School graduates attended the two-year medical course at the University prior to 1927. One in every three physicians in Wisconsin has had some training at the University of Wisconsin Medical School. Wisconsin leads the Medical Schools of the midwest in the number of graduates who pass the State Board examinations and in twelve of the past twenty years no Wisconsin medical student has failed to pass the State Board examinations.

The preceptor plan, initiated by Dr. Bardeen, is an important part of the educational program of the Medical School which has been copied by many other medical schools. Last year 242 physicians came to the campus for instruction in eight courses and a total of 768 physicians participated in one form or another of adult education sponsored by the Medical School. Dean Middleton reported there is a keen and continuing interest in adult medical education.

The Dean stated that quite possibly the total educational responsibility of the Medical School may not be fully appreciated. In addition to the 324 regularly enrolled medical students, the Medical School is responsible for the training of internes, residents, nurses, occupational therapists and x-ray and medical technicians. Including these, a total of 1084 students are taught in Medical School and auxiliary courses. In addition there are 1259 non-medical students enrolled in various medical school courses; in other words, a grand total of 2343 students are taught by the Medical School faculty.

The second major field of the Medical School is human service. The University Hospitals are the largest single University laboratory. The hospitals have treated a total of 280,000 patients since 1924. In addition, the State Laboratory of Hygiene and the Psychiatric Institute are responsibilities of the Medical School administration. Last year these laboratories examined more than 480,000 specimens.

Research is the third field of Medical School activity. In addition to many incidental research activities of the faculty the Medical School includes three separately organized research units; namely, the McArdle Memorial Laboratory for Cancer Research, the Cardiovascular Research Laboratory and the Laboratory for Research in Arthritis. Last year the Medical School expended \$546,922 for research.

Dean Middleton reported that since he became Dean the entire staff of the Medical School has been replaced. He said Wisconsin has the strongest faculty in the basic sciences in the country. The faculty includes 86 full-time staff members, 24 part-time staff members and 28 student assistants, etc., or a total of 138 staff members.

In addition to the above mentioned direct responsibilities of the Medical School, Dean Middleton mentioned the work of the Medical School with affiliated organizations, such as the Veterans Administration Hospital, the Enzyme Institute and the Diagnostic Center.

President Fred stated that the Regents since 1951 had made it a practice
to give consideration at the close of the football season to the salaries of the
football staff. However, he stated that he had received a letter from the Head

Football Coach requesting that the members of the football staff receive consideration in University affairs and problems in the same manner as the faculty in general and that increases in their salaries be made at the same time and on the same basis of merit as all members of the faculty. President Fred read the letter received by him from Ivan B. Williamson, Head Football Coach, dated November 30, 1953, which follows:

"The members of the football staff feel that they should receive consideration in university affairs and problems in the same manner that the faculty in general does.

"In view of this, we do not want a review of our salaries made until the time that it is done for all faculty members.

"We want the decision in respect to increases for us made on the same basis of merit that it is made for all members of the faculty."

Regent Gelatt stated that this was a very public spirited move on the part of the head coach and his staff, one which will increase the harmony which already exists here on the campus.

Upon motion of Regent Laird, seconded by Regent Jones, it was VOTED, That the above request of the members of the football staff be accepted with commendation.

II. Miscellaneous

The Vice President of Business and Finance presented, for the information of the Regents, the following report:

On August 9, 1952, the Regents approved the sale of the undivided 3/8ths interest of The Regents of The University of Wisconsin in the Harriet J. Sawyer Estate vacant land, located in Blue Island, Illinois, for a consideration of \$600. Since that sale was completed, an additional vacant lot has been found, which is being sold under the above authorization for a consideration of \$75. (Elsa A. Sawyer Memorial Scholarship Trust Fund)

III. Budget Transfers

The Vice President of Business and Finance presented the report of budget transfers for November, 1953, for the information of the Regents. (EXHIBIT C attached)

Vice President Peterson reported that Judge Proctor had ruled that certain rules and regulations included in the Rules and Regulations for the Management, Administration and Regulation of Land and Property Owned or Controlled by the University adopted by the Regents on September 12, 1953, are illegal and void. He stated that the Attorney General's Office has worked on that problem since the decision was made by the Court and presented amendments for the consideration and approval of the Regents. Upon motion of Regent Rennebohm, seconded by Regent Laird, it was

VOTED, That the Rules and Regulations for the Management, Administration and Regulation of Land and Property Owned or Controlled by the University of Wisconsin adopted by the Regents of the University of Wisconsin at their regular meeting held on September 12, 1953, be amended in part as shown in EXHIBIT D, attached.

Regent Renk presented the report of the Educational Committee.

Upon motion of Regent Renk, seconded by Regent Laird, it was
VOTED, That the following recommendations of the Educational Committee be
adopted:

1. That Mrs. Lois G. Nemec, associate professor of education, Extension Division, be changed from half-time to part-time for the first semester of 1953-54; and that her salary be increased from \$302.50 to \$402.50 per pay period for the first semester (salary for the academic year increased from \$3,025 to \$3,525); charge to 1A-1B, Sp. Cl. 30 Ext. Staff.
2. That the leave of absence, without pay, granted to Norman C. Fassett, professor of botany, for the first semester of 1953-54, be cancelled in favor of a research appointment; and that his salary for the academic year be fixed at \$7,800, to be distributed as follows: \$780 for the period September 14 to October 8, 1953, to be charged to Chemistry 16D-605; \$3,120 for the period October 9, 1953 to February 2, 1954, to be charged to Botany 16D-825; and \$3,900 for the second semester of 1953-54 to be charged to Botany 1A-1B, as budgeted.
3. That F. H. Elwell, Dean of the School of Commerce, be granted leave of absence on the summer session basis for the five weeks' period beginning February 1, 1954; salary of \$1,298.07 for the period to be distributed \$416.67 to Summer Session Trust Fund, \$881.40 to Commerce 1A-1B; saving of \$416.67 to be credited to Commerce 1A-1B budget.
4. That, upon the recommendation of the Dean of the College of Agriculture, approval be given to a change in the terms of the memorandum agreement with the National Chinchilla Breeders of America, Inc., approved by the Regents on November 10, 1951, to provide^{for} a reduction

of \$16,000 in the grant for research and the elimination of that phase of the research work dealing with diseases which the College of Agriculture has been unable to undertake because qualified personnel has not been available. (Total grant reduced from \$47,000 to \$31,000 for three years ending November 1, 1954)

Upon motion of Regent Jones, seconded by Regent Renk, it was VOTED, That the bequest by the late Eva J. S. Olwell, of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, for the establishment of The Lawrence A. Olwell Scholarship Fund, in memory of her late husband, who was an alumnus of the University of Wisconsin Law School, Class of 1892, be accepted by The Regents of The University of Wisconsin in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Last Will and Testament of Eva J. S. Olwell, Deceased; and that the Secretary be authorized to accept and sign receipts for this bequest in the name of The Regents of The University of Wisconsin, and do all things necessary to effect the transfer of this bequest to the University of Wisconsin.

Upon motion of Regent Jones, seconded by Regent Laird, it was VOTED, That, subject to the approval of the Governor, the President and the Secretary be authorized to sign a two-year lease from The Regents of The University of Wisconsin to Wood County, Wisconsin, covering a parcel of land of 0.23395 acres at the Marshfield Branch Experiment Station, on which Wood County, at its expense, will construct an Office and Service Building.

Vice President Rennebohm took the Chair.

Upon motion of Regent Jones, seconded by Regent Renk, it was VOTED, That, subject to the approval of the Governor and of the State Chief Engineer, the Vice President of Business and Finance be authorized to sign an amendment to the agreement between The Regents of The University of Wisconsin and Charles S. Whitney, Engineer, and Fitzhugh Scott—Fitzhugh Scott, Jr., Architects, to provide for the revision of the plans and specifications and the supervision of construction for the Indoor Practice Building.

Upon motion of Regent Jones, seconded by Regent Watson, it was VOTED, That the Fund 16B Research budget for 1953-54 of the College of Agriculture be increased in the amount of \$2,500 (\$185 Supplies and Expense, and \$2,315 Capital), on account of an additional allotment of Federal funds.

President Werner resumed the Chair.

These temporary scholarship recipients would not be in competition with the regular recipients; i.e., the semi-permanent standing of the regular recipients would not be affected by the performance of the temporary students.
2. Renewals: Awards may be automatically renewed from year to year to the end of the regular four-year undergraduate course and through not more than four years of graduate work if the scholar submits application and continues to qualify. A 1.75 grade-point average shall be maintained by the student who receives the scholarship.
3. Administration: The fund is to be administered through the Committee on Loans and Undergraduate Scholarships,

4. Amount of the Scholarships: Undergraduate scholarships shall consist of sums of \$700 each. Graduate scholarships shall be at least that amount and shall be decided when the occasion arises.

Section 7.33 of the Rules and Regulations for the Management, Administration and Regulation of Land and Property Owned or Controlled by the University of Wisconsin adopted by The Regents of the University of Wisconsin at their regular meeting held on September 12, 1953 is amended to read as follows:

7.33 Motor vehicle regulations. (1) No person shall operate a motor vehicle on any roadway under the control of the Regents while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or any narcotic drug or in a manner constituting and amounting to a high degree of negligence.

(2) (a) No person not holding a valid and current operator's license issued under section 85.08 of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1953 shall operate any motor vehicle on any roadway under the control of the Regents unless exempt under the provisions of section 85.08(4) of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1953 from the requirement that he hold such license in order to operate a motor vehicle on the highways of this state.

(b) No person shall operate any motor vehicle on any roadway under the control of the Regents unless the same has been properly registered as provided by sections 85.01 to 85.055, inclusive, of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1953.

(3) All provisions of chapter 85 of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1953 entitled "Law of the Road" which are applicable to highways as therein defined, are hereby adopted for the regulation of traffic on the roadways under the control of the Regents except as follows:

(a) Section 85.10(21)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1953 does not apply to this Regulation, but the term "highway" means the roadways under the control of the Regents.

(b) Penalties prescribed in chapter 85 of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1953 are inapplicable to these Regulations, but the penalties shall be those prescribed by statute for the violation of Rules and Regulations of the Regents.

(c) All provisions of chapter 85 of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1953 which do not regulate the movement of traffic or the stopping or parking of vehicles are excepted from this Regulation.

(d) Sections 85.46 to 85.54, inclusive, of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1953, relating to the weight of vehicles, are excepted from this Regulation.

(e) All provisions of chapter 85 of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1953 which are in conflict with any section of these Regulations are excepted.

(4) If any provision of this Regulation is invalid, or if the application thereof to any person or circumstance is invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application.

The "Note" appended to the Rules and Regulations for the Management, Administration, and Regulation of Land and Property Owned or Controlled by the University of Wisconsin adopted at their regular meeting held on September 12, 1953, is hereby amended to read:

Note: The penalties for violating these rules and regulations are those set forth or referred to in section 27.01(2), (3), (4), (5) and (8) of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1953. See sections 23.09(11) and 26.19 of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1953, and see section 36.06 (8) of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1953 as amended by section 13 of chapter 631 of the Wisconsin Laws of 1953.
