Harpaesis, foreman, to Matreas, the most honored, greetings. If it seems right to you, send me then from the coffers of the Julian gods the wages for dredging the bath of the festal hall, which is blocked up, forty-eight drachmas and for the costs of threshing the grass and the wheat and other works seventy-two drachmas, total 120 drachmas, of which I shall render an account. The year 23 of Antoninus Caesar, the lord, the 12th Mesore. Give the 120 drachmas. From Belleies, son of Anubion.
