

LOW PLASTER LOSS GYPSONA P.o.P. BANDAGES MEAN:

- 1 Minimum loss of plaster during soaking and squeezing.
- 2 Cleanliness in handling.
- 3 Less plaster residue in buckets, bowls, on the hands, on the drapes, and on the floor.

The two bandages shown here are being subjected to approximately the same amount of pressure after dipping. The marked difference of plaster loss is immediately apparent between an ordinary bandage (on the left) and "L.P.L." Gypsona.
