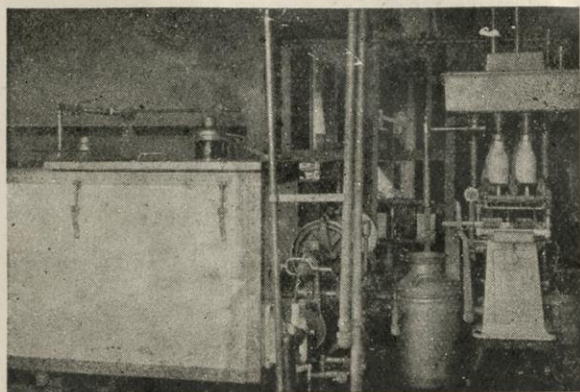

CITY FIRE ALARM SYSTEM

How It Operates

To Turn in an Alarm—Break the glass in the door of the box, or if the key is in the door, open it, then pull down the handle as far as it will go, and let it go. The water works whistle should blow within 3 or 4 seconds.

If you telephone the alarm, Do Not Call for the Electric Light Plant. Give "Central" the name and address of the fire. She will do the rest.

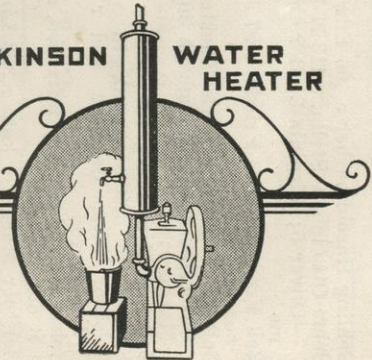

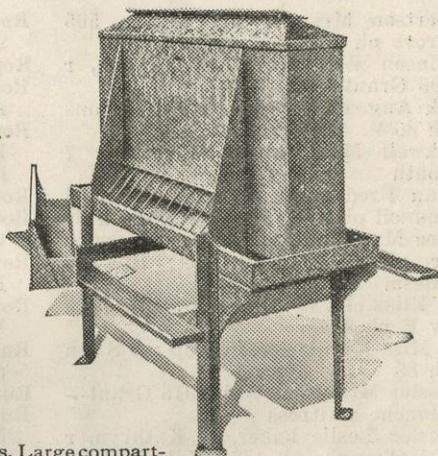

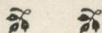
