THE UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN SYSTEM

The University of Wisconsin System is making its 12th anniversary in the fall of 1983. The UW System was created in October 1971 by a law placing all of the state's public university campuses under a single Board of Regents. The 13 universities and 14 two-year UW-Centers served 158,971 on-campus students in 1981-82, and UW-Extension provides outreach services from offices in every county. Although only twelve years old, the UW-System was one of the first statewide higher educational systems in the nation and has pioneered in developing coordinated and high quality programs and services on a statewide basis. System administrative offices are in Madison.

Universities are in Eau Claire, Green Bay, La Crosse, Madison, Milwaukee, Oshkosh, Kenosha-Racine (Parkside), Platteville, River Falls, Stevens Point, Menomonie (Stout), Superior and Whitewater. Centers are at Baraboo, Fond du Lac, Janesville, Manitowoc, Marinett, Marshfield, Menasha, Rice Lake, Richland Center, Sheboygan, Waukesha, Wausau, and West Bend.

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HISTORY OF THE WWIAC

1958-The Wisconsin Athletic and Recreation Federation was formed for the purpose of coordinating athletic activity among Wisconsin institutions of higher education. This organization followed the national model (ARFCW) in which governance was primarily the responsibility of student leaders. The WARFCW included representatives from:

Eau Claire State College
La Crosse State College
University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee
Oshkosh State College
Platteville State College
Ripon College
River Falls State College
University of Wisconsin-Madison

The WARFCW held sports days in Archery, Badminton, Basketball, Golf, Gymnastics, Tennis and Volleyball.

1966-A motion to form a women's athletic conference presented, but defeated.

1969-Annual convention held at Carthage College, Kenosha. Motion to limit number of sports days per sport to one was passed. This constituted a state meet in each particular sport. Member institutions would be allowed to travel to other member schools for dual meets.

1970-Spring meeting held in Stevens Point. Directive issued by President van Steenderen that Wilson and Mullen seek information about the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Organization for Women and the Wisconsin State University Conference (WSUC). Changes and additions made to existing constitution.

Fall, 1970- WARFCW member school advisors officially agree to develop an athletic conference for women. Committee appointed to draft the constitution for the Wisconsin Women's Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WWIAC). This committee included:

Jan. 31, 1971-The representatives vote unanimously for the WWIAC.

HISTORY OF THE WWIAC (continued)

March 26 & 27, 1971-First scheduled WWIAC governing body meeting on the Stevens Point State University campus. The 12 member institutions and their representatives were:

Mary Jo Mullen was appointed Chair; Dr. Patricia Collins, Chair-elect, and Kit Saunders, Secretary-Treasurer.

Fall, 1971-University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee joined WWIAC. Thirteen total member schools.

1972-WWIAC became affiliated member of the Midwest Association for Intercollegiate Athletics for Women (MAIAW).

1972-University of Wisconsin merged with the Wisconsin State University System.

Fall, 1973-Carroll College joined WWIAC. Fourteen total member schools

Fall, 1974-University of Wisconsin-Green Bay joined the WWIAC. Fifteen total member schools.

Fall, 1975-Marquette University joined WWIAC. Sixteen total member schools.

1975-University of Wisconsin System allocated part time position for coordination of WWIAC. Gail Grimm appointed Executive Secretary.

1977-Executive Secretary position expanded to full-time position on interim basis. Dr. Emogene A. Nelson named to that position.

1978-Council of Chancellors appointed a Council of Six (plus one to be named by private colleges) to serve liaison functions with WWIAC, WSUC and WCC. Executive Secretary title changed to Commissioner, WWIAC.

1979-Council of Six, in concert with the WWIAC, conducts national Search and Screen effort. Dr. Janice M. Stocker hired as Commissioner commencing August 1, 1979.

HISTORY OF WWIAC (continued)

1980-Dr. Janice M. Stocker served her first year as Commissioner of WWIAC. Liaison was established with the Independent schools of Wisconsin. Consolidation of Boards of Officials. New Board: Wisconsin (NAGWS) Board of Officials located at UW-Whitewater under the direction of Mary Ann Riccio.

1981-New Commission: Wisconsin AIAW Commission to establish policies and procedures for State (Qualifying) Tournaments - Lee Stephenson, Chair. Assignment of basketball officials for conference games from WWIAC Office.

1982-AIAW/MAIAW defunct. Member institutions identifying with other national governing bodies - NCAA/NAIA. First Scholar-Athlete banquet held at Maple Bluff Country Club in Madison.

1983-Restructure of WWIAC. No divisional structure for Championships.

WWIAC POST-SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

- Cross Country: The WWIAC proved it was the nation's toughest league as conference runners dominated both the NAIA and NCAA-Division III meets. Marquette, led by national champion Katie Webb, easily ran to the NAIA crown. Eau Claire finished second in that meet as Deanna Marchello took second overall and Carolyn Shield third. Parkside finished eighth in the meet. At the NCAA meet, La Crosse's Tori Neubauer sped to the individual title, helping the Roonies grab second place. Oshkosh ended up seventh in the meet.
- Field Hockey: Stevens Point, after winning its third straight conference title, was chosen to participate in the NCAA-Division III meet. But a national championship was not in the cards as the nation's 13th ranked team, Stevens Point, was eliminated in the opening round of the tournament.
- Swimming: Eau Claire finally reached its elusive goal of winning a national title as the Blugolds captured the NAIA meet. Colleen Hunstad (diving), Lisa Roettger (diving), and Brenda Dahl (backstroke) all won individual titles for Eau Claire, which grabbed nine seconds at the meet. Two other schools also fared well at the meet. Green Bay finished sixth and Milwaukee took ninth place.
- Gymnastics: Oshkosh, the perennial powerhouse in the WWIAC, once again qualified for post-season competition. But the Titans were eliminated from the NCAA-Division III meet in regional competition. At the NAIA meet, four conference schools placed high as La Crosse, took sixth, Superior 10th, Eau Claire 12th and Milwaukee 13th.
- Volleyball: La Crosse fell just one victory short of qualifying for the NCAA Division III finals as it was ousted from the championship round of its own regional. In the NAIA meet, a first round loss spelled the end of Milwaukee's dream to win a national title.
- Basketball: La Crosse, which rebounded from an early season bus accident to win the conference title, advanced all the way to the quarterfinal round of the NCAA-Division III title before falling in overtime. Along the way, the Roonies eliminated conference rival Whitewater. In NAIA competition, Milwaukee qualified for the Area 4 playoff but lost to Missouri-Kansas City.
- Track and Field: La Crosse added some building blocks as it continued to construct a dynasty by winning another national title. Last season, the Roonies won the AIAW meet. This spring, La Crosse, led by Tori Neubauer and Cindy Lensmire, captured the NCAA-Division III meet. Neubauer set records in winning both the 3,000- and 5,000-meter runs while Lensmire did the same in the shot put and discus. Mary Kastelic (800-meter run) also won an individual title for La Crosse.

WWIAC POST-SEASON HIGHLIGHTS (continued)Softball:

Two WWIAC teams participated in post-season play but were quickly eliminated. Parkside went furthest, advancing to the second round of NAIA meet while Whitewater was eliminated in the first round of the NCAA-Division III tournament.
