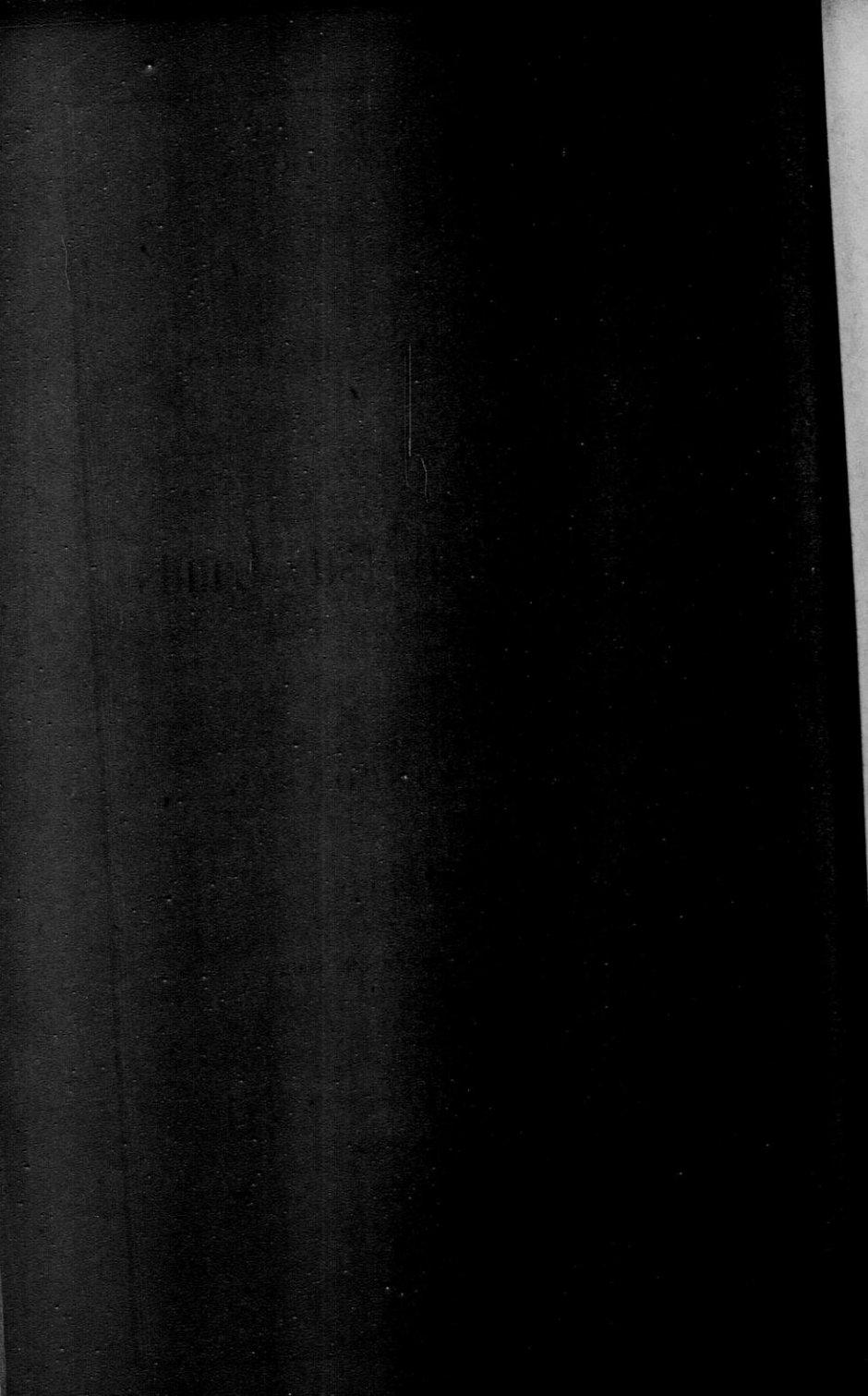

To His Excellency,

Governor EDWARD SALOMON,

SIR:—The commissioners for the sale of school, university and swamp lands, having the care thereof, and having in charge the funds arising from such sales, would respectfully submit this, their annual report for the fiscal year ending September 30th, 1862.

The reports of the secretary of state and of the state treasurer, exhibit full and detailed statements of the receipts and disbursements on account of the several funds over which we have supervision, and to which we would respectfully refer.

### LOANS.

The amount of loans made to individuals during the past year has been as follows:

From the principal of the school fund.....	\$51,478 00
From the principal of the university fund.....	850 00
From the principal of the drainage fund.....	1,475 00

A large portion of these loans have been made to purchasers who have purchased land at the sale of mortgaged lands as provided in section 113 of chapter 28 of the revised statutes, and to those who have patented lands under the provisions of chapter 341 of the general laws of 1860. A few of the loans are merely exchanges of securities made in accordance with the provisions of chapter 236 of the general laws of 1862.

On the 14th day of March, 1862, an act was approved authorizing the investment of the school fund in the bonds of the state. In accordance with the provisions of this law, (chapter 89 of the general laws of 1862) sixty-five thousand dollars of the school fund have been invested in the war bonds of the state of Wisconsin. The undersigned are of the opinion that the change in the manner of the investment of this sacred fund,

is a most wise one. The trouble and expense of the management of the fund are materially diminished, while its safety is secured beyond all possible question. They would earnestly recommend that the law be so changed that the commissioners can invest the fund in any of the bonds issued by the state of Wisconsin.

### NOTES ACCOMPANYING FORFEITED MORTGAGES.

We would invite attention to the following suggestions contained in the last annual report of our predecessors:

"There are now many notes in hands of the commissioners given with mortgages to secure loans upon which a large balance is due to the state, the mortgaged premises having been sold to the state for a sum less than the loan.

These notes should all be put into judgment. The commissioners have not caused it to be done because there is no money under their control with which to pay the costs that must inevitably be made. They recommend an appropriation for that purpose."

### RACINE CITY MORTGAGES.

The undersigned would respectfully call attention to the suggestions made by their predecessors on page 6 of their report for the year 1861.

To the Hon. the Assembly of the State of Wisconsin:

We have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of the accompanying resolution, No. 37, A., and would hereby make the following response to the same.

Statement marked "A," herewith presented, contains the information asked in items 1st, 2d, 3d, and 4th.

The information asked for in items 5th, 6th and 7th, it is impossible to procure, as in the early years of the state government, the records of the department were not kept so as to preserve the information now sought to be procured.

The reply to the 8th item will be found in statement marked "B." This statement gives the names of all persons who have had loans and forfeited them. No one who has thus forfeited a loan is now in the employ of the departments under the control of the undersigned.

In reply to the 9th item, we would say that no fee whatever has ever been charged to the mortgagee, so far as our knowledge extends.

Statement marked "C" contains a reply to item 10.
