I BROUGT IT INTO THE OFFICE TO FRANCIS AND HE WENT ON THE AIR IMMEDIATELY AND BROADCAST IT AS WELL AS ALL THE NEWS THAT FOLLOWED.

THEN HE ANNOUNCED THE NEWS FROM THE STAGE OF THE MIKADOW AND AFTER DOS TED NEWS NEWS RELEASES ON THE DOORS AND WINDOWS.

THIS NEWS BROUGHT PEOPLE TO THE RADIO STATION WHERE
THOSE WHO HAD PEOPLE ON ISLANDS STAYED WAITING FOR MORE
NEWS AND DETAILS ABOUT THE ATTACK. SOME BROUGHT LUNCHES
AND REMAINEDINTO THE NITE.

FOR OVER A WEEK THE DOORS OF THE STATION WERE NOT LOCKED

AS PEOPLE CAME AND LEFT. PEOPLE WERE ON DUTY AROUND THE
