Wesley E. Field Wounded, Report

Corp. Wesley E. Field, son of Mr. and Mrs. Harvey S. Field Mt. Horeb, was wounded by shrapnel in the right arm and leg, Nov. 26, in France. He is in the infantry, in Gen. Patton's Third army. Before entering service, he was with the Wisconsin Telephone Co. in Madison. He has been in Corp. Field service since Mar. 19, 1943.
