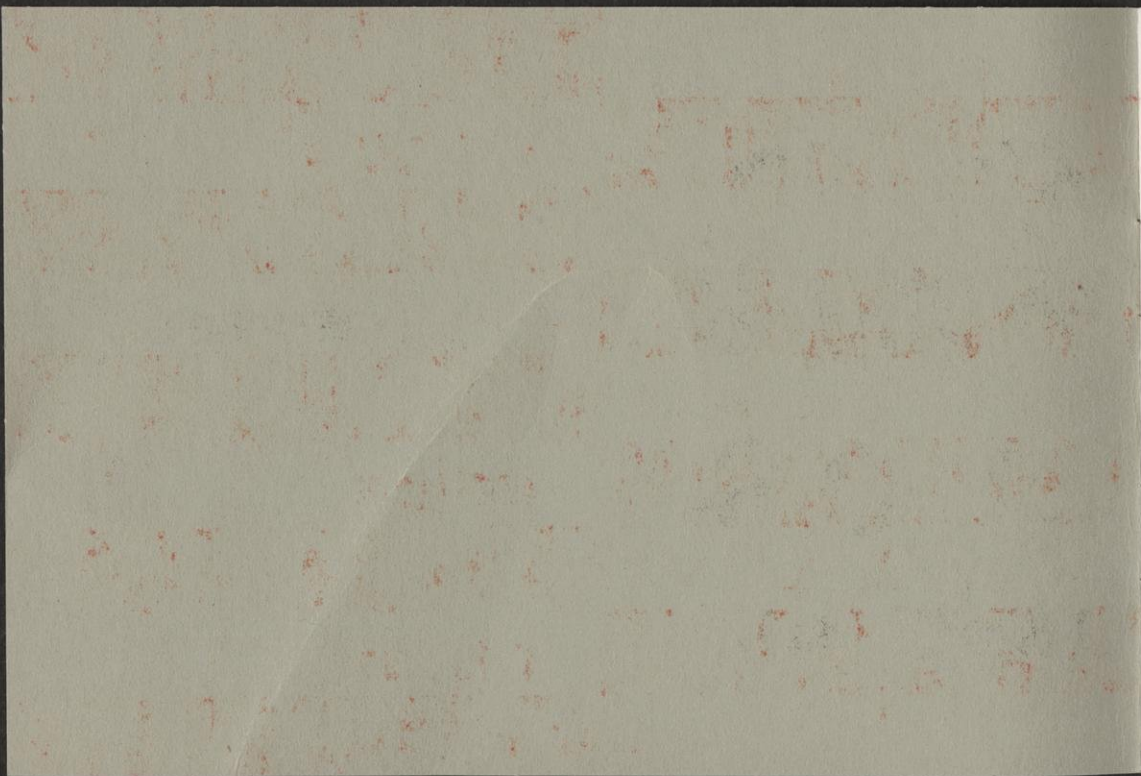

In this, the Twentieth Wisconsin Salon of Art, Wisconsin people have an opportunity to view a jury selected exhibition of Wisconsin artists' works. That in itself is not especially noteworthy, but it is noteworthy that the conception of the Salon, the planning and execution of the many details for its showing have been performed by the student members of the Union Gallery Committee as a means to present these artists to their community. The salon has become a well established tradition without any of the stultifying effects of Tradition, either upon the artists, whose works are presented here, or upon the members of the Gallery Committee.

Each year we note the sustained vitality and inventiveness in the works of the artists, and we have become accustomed to looking for new names as well as more familiar names in the catalog. Yet we are seldom aware of the hours of work performed by the Committee in sending out announcements, receiving and safeguarding entries, selecting and arranging for the jurors and working with them in selecting these works, then installing the exhibition, arranging for the opening reception and announcement of awards, publicizing the exhibition and finally, the returning of the works to the artists after the close of the

exhibition. Yes, this is all work and learning by doing, and they all learn much about bringing artists and communities into closer and more meaningful relationships. However, we are the real beneficiaries who owe our appreciation to the Gallery Committee.

STATISTICS

270 artists submitted 422 works of art in oil and tempera, watercolor, pastel, sculpture, and graphics with a limit of two entries per person.

94 works were selected by the jury for exhibition in the Salon.

The contributors who were eligible have had three years residence in Wisconsin including the past year, or were ten-year residents in Wisconsin if now living outside of the state, or are faculty or students now in Wisconsin art schools.
