# THE CITY OF SHEBOYGAN.

**I**N issuing this Souvenir Program of the Street Fair and Carnival conducted by the Sheboygan Lodge, No. 299, B. P. O. E., from August 25th to 30th, inclusive, 1902, it may not be amiss, in a cursory way, to give a brief sketch of the City of Sheboygan, from which the Lodge hails, and which it is proud to call its home.

Situated picturesquely on the western shore of Lake Michigan, some one hundred miles north of the southern boundary line of the State of Wisconsin, on a broad plateau rising high above the bright blue waters of the lake and nestled securely among its numerous parks and groves, it is indeed an ideal city.

Its early history is co-extensive with the early history of the Territory and State. Founded by Indians it takes its name from their nomenclature.

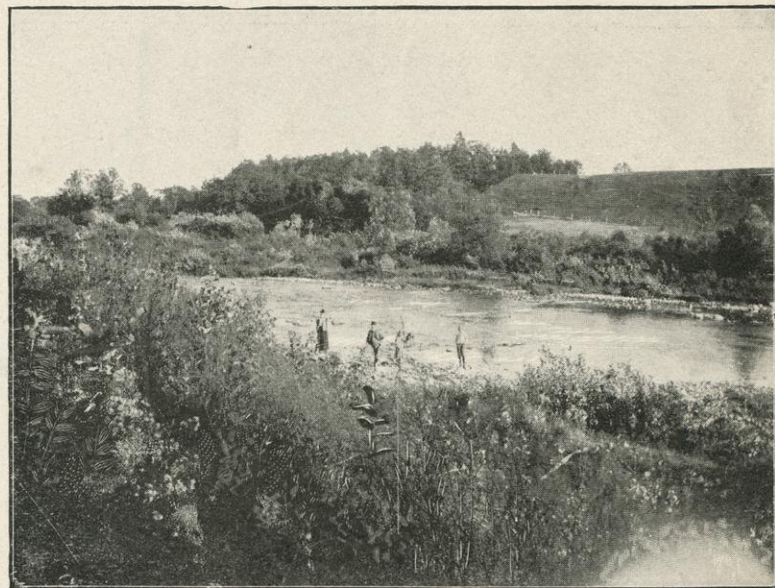
For a great many years Sheboygan remained simply a trading village, like many others of like character which dotted the shores of the lake. It has grown, however, to majestic proportions, so that to-day we behold a city regular in its plan, its streets wide, well-kept and ornamented with magnificent shade trees, its homes, churches, commercial and public buildings modern and in the best of architectural style and taste, with perfect sanitation and all the improvements, conveniences and facilities which mark a model city in this age.

It is eminently a healthy city. Its climate is affected to a marked degree by Lake Michigan. The extreme cold of winter and heat of summer is modified through its influence, consequently the results that usually follow either extreme are unknown to its people, leaving them very vigorous and energetic.

The growth of the city may be said to date from the early seventies, when, with a population of about 7,000, its people began to establish themselves in manufacture, not in one branch only, but in

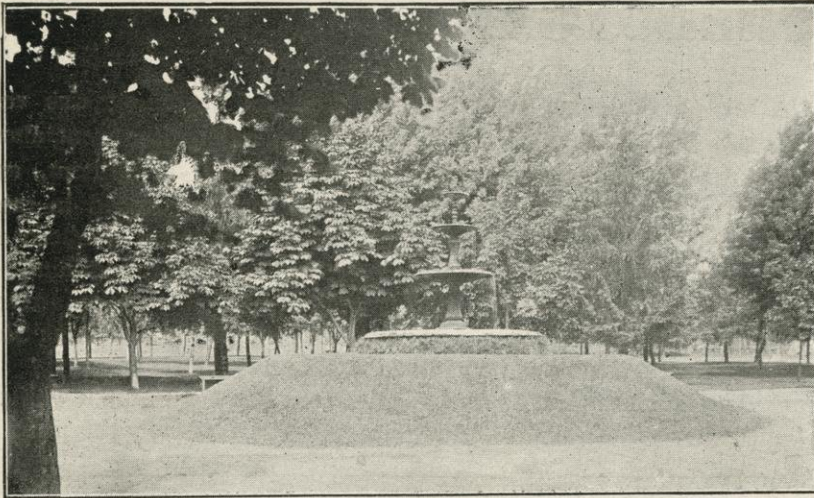
several at the same time. It is true the beginning was very modest, but the men at the head of these enterprises went about it in a business-like way, asking no assistance from without, and through pluck, energy and indomitable will have succeeded in rearing giant plants all well equipped with the most modern of improvements and machinery, representing an investment of many millions of dollars, giving employment the year around to a vast army of employes, and have aided materially in making Sheboygan a city of over 25,000 inhabitants in a decade.

Too much can not be said in praise of these silent, quiet workers for Sheboygan's growth and welfare, yet this is hardly the place to

go into detail. Suffice it to say that they, one and all, have earned for themselves a distinction more enduring than marble or bronze, for they are looked up to at home, and fully recognized abroad as enrolled among the great "Captains of Industry" of this great country of ours.

Hand in hand with this growth of Sheboygan industrial went the growth of its financial institutions, ever lending willing and ready aid wherever same was required, until to-day they stand as the leading institutions of their kind in the state, with combined capital and deposits, according to the last reports, of about \$5,000,000.

The shipping facilities of Sheboygan could not well be bettered, being in communication both by rail and water with all points of the compass. No locality can overreach her for receiving and shipping both raw material and manufactured product.

Being a manufacturing city, Sheboygan is dependent upon its labor, the supply of which is always abundant. As a class the work-

ers are industrious and intelligent, most of them owning their own homes, thus making Sheboygan emphatically a "City of Homes." Home influence here flourishes in all its kindly and refining glory. Everyone works as a unit for the best interests of the city. Everything conducive to comfort and refinement are to be found here, the city being supplied with electric lights, telephone exchanges, an efficient police force, a paid fire department, good water supply, an excellent sewerage system, a street railway and theaters, liberally supported schools which rank high, churches of all denominations.

Back of the city is a county rich in agricultural products common to this climate, ranking as of first importance in the production of cheese and other dairy products.

Sheboygan has immense Malt Houses.

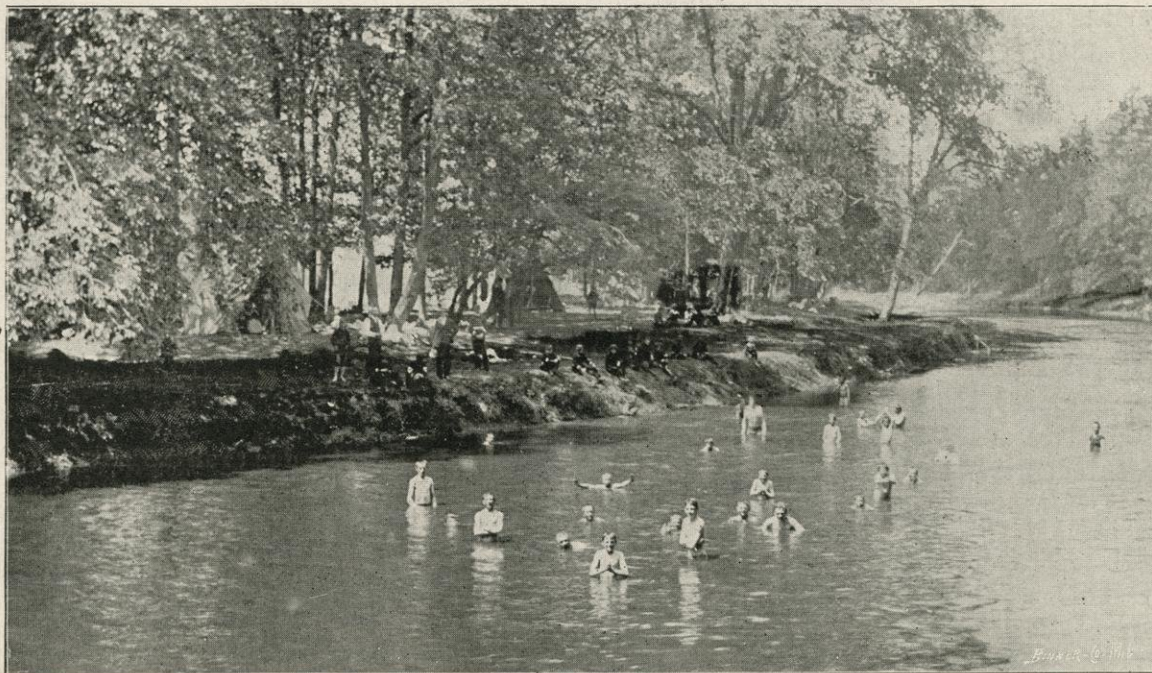
Sheboygan has a leading Glove Factory.

# History of the Street Fair and Carnival

To the majority of the people the why and wherefore of things is always of more or less interest, hence it may not be out of place to say something of the movement that resulted in our Street Fair and Carnival.

Early in July propositions were made to the Lodge looking to the advisability of holding a Fair in the city of Sheboygan, under the auspices of the Sheboygan Lodge, No. 299. After considering the matter carefully, notwithstanding the time was very short, with its usual energy the Lodge decided to take hold of the matter, and at once started upon the execution of the plan.

A committee of fifteen, composed of John Cuddy, John R. Riess, G. W. Kent, W. C. Roenitz, A. J. Pfister, W. R. Kowalke, T. M. Bowler, O. C. Neumeister, E. L. Debell, O. B. Bock, C. H. Roenitz, Theo. Fleischer, Felix Benfey, J. E. Matthewson and C. F. Kade, was appointed by the Lodge, to be known as the Executive Committee, and which was to have the management and charge of such Fair.

At the first meeting of the Executive Committee the same organized by electing Bros. John Cuddy, President; G. W. Kent, Secretary, and Adolph Pfister, Treasurer. Thereupon the following special committees were constituted, and the Chairman thereof elected as follows:

*Finance*—Adolph Pfister.

*Buildings and Grounds*—T. M. Bowler.

*Promotion, Advertisement and Press*—John R. Riess.

*Transportation*—W. R. Kowalke.

*Decoration and Illumination*—E. L. Debell.

*Parade and Music*—O. B. Bock.

*Concessions*—Charles H. Roenitz.

*Ladies' Auxiliary*—Felix Benfey.

Thereafter daily meetings were held of the Executive Committee, at which the Special Committees reported and received instructions, all of them working with a determination and will which showed the good progress by them made.

To Bro. John Cuddy special praise is due for the untiring devotion he brought to the task of marshalling an unknown quantity into the proper activities to bring about desired results. Much of the success of the Fair is due to his tact, energy and wisdom. His work has been painstaking and conscientious, his management masterful.

All honor to the ladies of our Lodge and Club—they quickly answering the call for aid have done yeoman's service; in matters of special concessions and booths their advice and suggestions have been invaluable, and much of the success of the Fair and Carnival, to which we looked forward, must be placed to the credit of our lady workers. Mrs. Emilie Kent presides over the actions of the Ladies' Committee.

Yet praise is also due to all the members of the Lodge. Although all are known to be busy men, with little time at their command outside of their regular callings, all have responded willingly whenever called upon for duty, and it is because of this that we look to a successful fruition of the work. Mistakes have no doubt been made, but this was unavoidable in the haste—the best of intention has prevailed to make the Fair and Carnival a grand success. How well we may have succeeded we must let each visitor judge. Be lenient.



# Sheboygan Lodge, No. 299, B. P. O. E.

Our Lodge can hardly be said to have a history. It was organized only seven years ago and the leading events of its short life are about as follows:

In the year 1895 Brother Samuel Martin, of Milwaukee, than whom there is no more enthusiastic Elk, came to Sheboygan on a visit, and through his aid was enlisted the representative professional and business men to apply for a charter to organize a Lodge of Elks. Geele Block, in this city, was the first home of the Lodge, but before a year had rolled by its growth imperatively demanded larger quarters. These were found on the second floor of the building now occupied by the Lodge.

To Bro. George B. Mattoon belongs the honor of having been the first member to be initiated by Sheboygan Lodge. Though a charter member, he was not present when the Grand Officers officiated at the initiation of the other members, hence the brothers had the privilege of initiating themselves a charter member of their own organization. The growth of the Lodge has been phenomenal; a

more representative gathering of citizens could hardly be thought of than the Lodge presents when a full membership attends its sessions. The continual growth and the intensifying interest in the Lodge soon developed a desire among the members for a suite of Club rooms, out of which desire grew the handsome home of the Lodge that has become one of the show places of the city. Two floors, in addition to the regular Lodge rooms, are devoted to Club purposes. Entering the Club house the visitor finds himself in a spacious, tastefully decorated reception hall; to the right of the corridor leading to the billiard room, in the rear of the first floor, are two smaller rooms where friends can be entertained. On this same floor are located the large cloak rooms, toilet rooms, the buffet and the kitchen. The basement has been fitted out with bowling alleys, the alleys being

much frequented at all times of the day during the season, and are regarded among the best equipped alleys in the state. It was here that the ladies bowling record was made for the state.

The second floor contains the Lodge rooms proper—one of the most spacious halls in the city—simply, yet impressively, fitted out: parlor, retiring rooms, cloak rooms, etc., add to the convenience of the members and their friends. The hall of the Elks is considered the finest dancing floor in the city.

In the space of a brief article it is impossible to dwell at any length upon the many points of interest and beauty to be found within the Club house; the same has become the favorite place of entertainment in the city.
