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

Sunday Sept 21 -

a very lonely day

right. Grandma and
Grandpa came down
to spend a little time,
it pleased us very
much. You did
wait on them so
nicely by serving a
little glass of wine
and a piece of cake
on a silver - It
looked so sweet and
pleased them too -

Monday Sept 22

This is Mamma busy
day again - And
this is my little
girl last week at
Kindergarten. Mamma
is almost glad to
see Russell is so very
lonely. Mamma loves
to have you together
all you can
possibly be. It
was a lonely afternoon
when you were
ready for play -
Mamma loves her girl.

Tuesday Sept- 23 -

My little girl came
home very tired but-
Mama let you go
with Papa down
to see a band etc-
came with Li' Plunket
You had a lonely
time but you came
home the most-tin
little girl I ever did
see - Then Mama
did not let you
have a long ev.
but - but you t- bed
very easily -

Wednesday Sept 24

This has been a
very busy day for
Mama for tomorrow
we are going to
give a surprise for
Mrs. Elliston and
you can hardly
wait for you and
Blanche and Janie
are to have a party.

It will mean much
to you though you
do not like the
idea of their leaving
the country.

Thursday Sept-25-

It was a very
rainy day and it
looked very much as
though our evening would
be spoiled for our good
time - But the rainy
turned out fine - You
climbed Blanchia Juniper
and you both had a
table all by yourselves -
You were very happy
indeed - and Mamma
knows you will
never forget the
lonely time you had
with your little
friends before they
went away.

Friday Sept 26

This was a very
happy day for my
little girl after
kindly after Helen
came down with
you to spend the
rest of the day and
Blanchie and Janie
came down for a
little while too -

You were very
happy over it all and
Mama was very
glad you were so
happy -

Saturday Sept 27 -

This was a busy day for my little girl for it was crowded with lots of things for you to do. The principal thing you did was to go and bid Blanche and Janie good-byes for they start on their trip tomorrow You were all broken up when you came home and Mamie felt very sorry for you indeed -

Sunday Sept-28

We just had a real good time. Papa was much surprised when he came in and found himself at his funeral in to a six o'clock dinner. The first question he asked was "where are the babies?" You see he missed you the very first thing.

This was a great day for my little son for you took an invitation to your kinder after teacher to come here tonight and take supper with you. She came and you had a most delightful time with her. She loved to have you all come to herself and you were most happy over it all -

seem very contented
to have Mama go.

Mama took brother down to Papai's shop and spent the evening at a friend's. We all took supper at the hotel together and then came home very happy and tired -

Thursday Oct. 18

This has been a very happy day for my little girl, for this morn Papa brought when he came to dinner a little white Puppy for you. A little Fox terrier four weeks old. You have named him "Walter". You were simply delighted. Brother has had a black one from the same litter for a week now you are both so happy. A dear good Papa your bairn. A very kind Papa to you -

We first went to church and Sunday School - then Uncle Frank took dinner with us and we had a very pleasant ride too - Mama set before you a good little lunch too and we all went to bed happy and in good spirits

Wednesday Oct. 20

This has been over
very beautiful day.

You little ones
have enjoyed it too,
It has been Mammas
birthday. Papa gave
me a five dollar gold
piece - We had a pleasant
time together this evening,

Papa would have
spent the evening with
us had he not been
invited out to a party
this evening himself.
